


Commencement Speaker

Robben W. Fleming
President, University of Michigan

Dr. Fleming became the ninth president of the University of Michigan in 1968, capping an admirable career of service to education, law, and labor. Prior to his Michigan appointment, President Fleming held the post of chancellor at the University of Wisconsin-Madison and filled academic positions at the University of Illinois and the University of Wisconsin. Recently he was elected chairman of the board of directors of the American Council on Education, an organization counting in its membership more than 1,300 colleges, universities, and educational associations. Dr. Fleming was president of the Association of American Universities for 1974-75, and this year he was named chairman of the Federal Advisory Committee for the Higher Education Equal Employment Opportunity Program. Widely known as a labor arbitrator, he has been a consultant to various government agencies in the field of manpower and labor management problems.

The Ohio State University is pleased to confer upon Dr. Fleming the honorary degree, Doctor of Laws, and to have him address the 258th graduating class.

Robben Wright Fleming

As attorney, as labor mediator and arbitrator, and as university president, Robben W. Fleming brings to difficult and delicate issues of policy an incisive mind, objectivity, willingness to listen, and a remarkable talent for helping antagonists reach creative consensus. All this would not be enough were it not for his enduring insistence on fairness. It is this combination of skills and values which confers upon Robben Fleming true distinction as a national leader in his profession, his university, and his country.

In recognition of his long and distinguished record of service, The Ohio State University hereby confers upon him the degree of Doctor of Laws, *honoris causa*.

Allen D. Manvel

In his distinguished professional career, Allen D. Manvel has exemplified the best traditions of the scholar-intellectual at work on public policy. As the principal architect of the modern census of governments, he developed the comparable fiscal information essential to policy decisions by presidents, governors, mayors, and elected officials at all levels of government. His pioneering work has laid the base for sophisticated analysis of the awesome complexities of government, especially at the state and local level. Above all, his lifetime of scholarly achievement testifies to the possibilities for creative scholarship within the federal service.

The Ohio State University hereby confers upon him the degree of Doctor of Science, *honoris causa*.

The Academic Costume

The colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University Commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics as well, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings made caps and floor-length capes with attached hoods a necessity for warmth. Probably because of the costumes' religious heritage, they remained drab until the universities gradually began to pass from the control of the Church, whereupon some aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. However, old prints and engravings reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and the academic costume worn today.

In light of our nation's strong English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity with regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed which prepared a code for caps, gowns, and hoods which has been adopted by all institutions. Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the more familiar mortarboard square — a shape which ballad folklore suggests resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship for it covers any dress which might indicate rank or social strata. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctor's degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the University.

The Gown

Bachelor Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.
Master Black, long or short sleeves with arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.
Doctor Black, with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

The Hood

Bachelor Three feet in length with a two-inch-wide velvet.*
Master Three and one-half feet in length with a three-inch-wide velvet.*
Doctor Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet and panel at the sides.
The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution from which the degree was received. The color of the velvet indicates the field in which the doctoral was granted:

Diplomas—Yesterday and Today

Today's degree candidates at Ohio State receive a diploma that is more substantial and better protected from the elements than its predecessors, one of which is shown on the cover. In 1890, graduates received a hand-lettered sheepskin diploma. Personally signed by the University's president, the diploma also bore the signatures of the professors in whose departments the student received instruction and the signatures of the president and the secretary of the Board of Trustees. The sheepskin, which measured approximately 16 × 20 inches, carried an embossed gold seal and was decorated with scarlet and gray grosgrain ribbons.

The 1910 commencement program had a tan leather cover on which the University's seal and the words Ohio State and 1910 were embossed. The inside pages were bound to the cover with brown leather laces. Featured on the cover was a rendering of old University Hall, the school's first academic building, which was replaced with a modern replica in 1976. The rendering was done in several colors of ink.

The Phalaenopsis orchid represents the more formal attire then worn for such occasions. Today, beneath the academic robes of the graduating class, one finds blue jeans and flannel shirts, leather sandals and tennis shoes.

Because of the large size of today's graduating class, sheepskin diplomas and leather-covered programs are not feasible economically. However, each diploma still is personalized and prepared, in part, by hand. Today's graduates receive their diplomas encased in protective red leatherette covers that are embossed with the University's seal.
