


Pomerene Hall

Pomerene Hall, originally called the Women's Building, was erected in the early 1920s and named for Frank E. Pomerene, an alumnus and former Trustee. Constructed of brick and cut stone in the English Tudor style, the building is located on Neil Avenue just south of the Oval, overlooking Mirror Lake. Pomerene Hall was built to serve as a social and recreational center for the University's women students. When completed in 1925, Pomerene Hall housed the office of the Dean of Women and contained gymnasiums, social rooms, a dining commons, and a natatorium. During World War II, the campus USO operated its canteen and staged weekend entertainment events for servicemen in Pomerene Hall's social rooms.

Pomerene Hall is now the home of the School of Health, Physical Education, and Recreation. Its pool and gymnasiums still ring with the sounds of physical education classes and sports activities. The original women's dining commons, later to become Pomerene Refectory, has been transformed into the Rathskeller, a popular campus dining and meeting place. In Pomerene Hall and across the campus, time and change are evident as men and women together enjoy the academic, social, and recreational dimensions of The Ohio State University.

Mary Rosamond Haas

Internationally recognized linguistics scholar, Mary Rosamond Haas is acknowledged as the leading senior figure in the study of native American languages. Her work and that of her students comprise the largest and most significant body of research on American Indian languages in the last 40 years. Her meticulous studies of the Thai and American Indian languages and cultures stand as scholarly landmarks. She has opened the way to new understandings of language and culture throughout the world. The Ohio State University is privileged to honor Mary Rosamond Haas for her long and illustrious career as research scholar, teacher, and author, and for her many contributions to knowledge.

Frederick G. Kilgour

Widely recognized innovator in the field of library science, Frederick G. Kilgour has won international acclaim for his leadership in applying computer technology to libraries. He is the principal architect of OCLC, Incorporated, a computer-based network that had its beginnings at this University. Today OCLC links more than 2,000 libraries in the United States and Canada. Soon the network will include major libraries in Europe. As a direct result of his unique contributions to information management, libraries now enjoy significant new economies and services. In testimony to the scholarly commitment that has marked his distinguished career, information is being placed at the service of people in new and imaginative ways.

J. W. Peltason

First as teacher and scholar in political science, then as academic administrator in major universities, and now as president of the American Council on Education, J. W. Peltason has served higher education with unique dedication and distinction. As chancellor of the University of Illinois during a decade of unrest and change, he demonstrated the sensitivity and strength that mark the gifted leader. Now, as the leading spokesman for higher education in Washington, he represents the academy with energy, wisdom, and, above all, with great vision. The Ohio State University is privileged to honor J. W. Peltason for his many contributions as an academic statesman of the highest order.

Howard Rosen

Almost single-handedly, Howard Rosen has advanced the frontier of human resource research. During the past 15 years, he has opened the way for American universities to study the development and utilization of human resources. He has nurtured a scholarly community to conduct such research and has used its findings to shape national policy. During his long and distinguished career with the Department of Labor, he has exemplified the highest traditions of public service. Under his creative leadership, government and the academy have worked in partnership and have forged a new understanding of the American labor force as a unique resource essential to the national well-being.

Distinguished Service Award


C. Joseph DeLor

Distinguished medical educator, physicians' physician, C. Joseph DeLor served this University for more than 40 years with singular dedication and devotion. Outstanding scientist, respected teacher, dedicated administrator, T. He is recognized nationally for his early work on vitamin A and his research in animal nutrition. 

The Academic Costume

The colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University Commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics as well, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings made caps and floor-length capes with attached hoods a necessity for warmth. Probably because of the costumes' religious heritage, they remained drab until the universities gradually began to pass from the control of the Church, whereupon some aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. However, old prints and engravings reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and the academic costume worn today.

In light of our nation's strong English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity with regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed which prepared a code for caps, gowns, and hoods which has been adopted by all institutions. Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the more familiar mortarboard square — a shape which ballad folklore suggests resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship for it covers any dress which might indicate rank or social strata. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctor's degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the University.

The Gown

Bachelor Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master Black, long or short sleeves with arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor Black, with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

The Hood

Bachelor Three feet in length with a two-inch-wide velvet.*

Master Three and one-half feet in length with a three-inch-wide velvet.*

Doctor Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution from which the degree was received. The color of the velvet indicates the field in which the doctoral was granted:

* Not usually worn by candidates for a degree.
