### Commencement Address

### Charles J. Ping

Charles J. Ping served for 19 years as president of Ohio University, leaving office last June to pursue research on the role of the university in contemporary society. He has been named a Fulbright Senior Research Scholar for Southern Africa and will spend a portion of the coming year in Namibia, Botswana, and Zimbabwe.

Dr. Ping graduated from Rhodes College in 1951 and received a bachelor of divinity degree from Louisville Presbyterian Theological Seminary in 1954. He earned his doctoral degree from Duke University and completed postdoctoral work at the Harvard University Graduate School of Business Administration.

Before becoming president of Ohio University in 1975, Dr. Ping taught philosophy at several universities, served as dean and acting president of Tusculum College in Tennessee, and as provost of Central Michigan University. As a professor of philosophy, his teaching specialties are 19th century philosophy and philosophy of religion.

His postdoctoral work in management has led to visiting professorships and numerous publications in the areas of labor relations, policy, and planning, particularly as they apply to universities.

Dr. Ping served as chair of the international division of the National Association of State Universities and Land-Grant Colleges and was on the executive committee of the association. He has been a member of a number of other advisory councils, commissions, and boards, including the American Council on Education's commission on women in higher education, the Educational Record editorial advisory board, the Kingdom of Swaziland's commission on planning for the future of higher education, and the presidential commission on higher education in the newly independent country of Namibia. He chairs the Council on International Education Exchange and has participated in a number of conferences and seminars focusing on the internationalization of universities.

Dr. Ping will return to Ohio University in the fall to teach full time as Trustee Professor of Philosophy and Education and to direct the Cutler Scholars Program, a newly endowed merit scholarship program.

Ohio State welcomes this eminent scholar and educational leader to address today's commencement.

## **Recipients of Honors**

### Rajammal P. Devadas Doctor of Humane Letters

As teacher, humanitarian, and nutritionist, Rajammal P. Devadas has been a leading advocate for improving the health and educational opportunities of the people of India for nearly half a century. Today she serves as chancellor of Avinashilingam Deemed University in Coimbatore, India.

A nutrition scholar of international renown, Dr. Devadas was among the first students to earn a B. S. degree in home science from the University of Madras in 1944. She received a scholarship from the Government of India to study at Ohio State, where she earned master's degrees in education and in nutrition and home science. In 1950, she became the first Indian citizen to receive a doctorate in nutrition and home science. She earned a post-doctoral degree from the University of Madras in 1978.

Upon completion of her studies at Ohio State, Dr. Devadas returned to India as the chief home economist and joint director of extension in the Ministry of Food and Agriculture, a post she held from 1955 to 1961. During this period she convinced Education Minister T.S. Avinashilingam, a noted educator and activist, to start a home science college for women in the state of Coimbatore. From 1960 to 1980 Dr. Devadas served as principal of the Sri Avinashilingam Home Science College, which today has become a nationally renowned university.

Throughout her career, Dr. Devadas has educated more than 10,000 teachers and has shared her studies through 360 research papers and 40 books. She is chief editor of the *Indian Journal of Nutrition and Dietetics*. She has represented India at over 50 international nutrition and home science conferences in nearly 40 countries.

Among her many honors and awards are the National Award for Child Welfare from the Ministry of Human Resource Development, the Tagore Literacy Award from the Indian Adult Education Association, and an honorary doctorate from Oregon State University.

It is with great pride that Ohio State honors this distinguished world leader in the fight against hunger and illiteracy.

### **Recipients of Honors**

### Richard H. Leet Distinguished Service Award

One of the university's most dedicated volunteer leaders, Richard H. Leet was instrumental in the resounding success of the five-year Ohio State University Campaign, completed in 1990.

Dr. Leet served as chair of the National Campaign Committee during the final years of the campaign and has been a member of The Ohio State University Foundation Board since 1986. As campaign chair, he spent countless hours meeting with committees, recruiting other volunteers, and working with potential donors. He is the recipient of the 1990 Mershon Award from The Ohio State University Alumni Association.

Born in Maryville, Mo., Dr. Leet graduated from Northwest Missouri State with a bachelor of science degree in chemistry and physics. After receiving his doctorate in chemistry in 1952 from Ohio State, he joined Standard Oil Company in Indiana (now Amoco) as a research chemist. He progressed through a number of assignments in marketing, manufacturing, and finance with Amoco Oil Company and Amoco Chemicals Company. In 1978 he was named president of Amoco Chemicals, serving for five years before being elected to the Amoco Corporation board of directors as executive vice president and subsequently vice chairman of the board until his 1991 retirement.

Dr. Leet continues his active involvement in business and community affairs. He serves as a board member of Vulcan Materials Corporation, Illinois Tool Works, Landauer Corporation, and Great Lakes Chemical Corporation. He is a member of the board of trustees of Brenau University in Gainesville, Georgia. Dr. Leet is also a long-time member and former chair of the board of managers for the metropolitan Chicago YMCA.

Long active in scouting, Dr. Leet is an Eagle Scout and has served as council, area, and regional president, and as national president of the Boy Scouts of America in 1990 and 1991. He is a recipient of the Silver Beaver, Silver Antelope, and Silver Buffalo awards as well as the Distinguished Eagle Award.

It is with deep gratitude that Ohio State recognizes the scope of Dr. Leet's continuing contributions to the university and to his community.

## William K. Willis Distinguished Service Award

A gifted athlete and a loyal alumnus, William K. Willis was a pioneer in opening the game of football to African-American players.

While playing on both the offensive and defensive lines for the Ohio State Buckeyes, Mr. Willis was a starter on the 1942 National Championship team and, in 1944, became the university's first African-American to gain All-American recognition as a member of that year's unbeaten Big 10 championship team.


The Columbus native received his bachelor's degree in education from Ohio State in 1945. Following graduation, he surmounted the racial barriers of the day to become a member of the original Cleveland Browns football team in 1946. He became a seven-time All-Pro middle guard during his eight-year pro career. His gridiron efforts earned him a place in the College Football Hall of Fame in 1971 and the Pro Football Hall of Fame in 1977, making him one of only two Buckeye double honorees.

Mr. Willis returned to Ohio State to attend graduate school in 1948 and, after his retirement from pro football, turned his efforts toward the community, serving as assistant commissioner of the Cleveland City Recreation Department. In 1963 he moved back to Columbus as deputy director of the Ohio Youth Commission. In 1975 he was appointed director of the Department of Youth Services by Governor James Rhodes. He retired from that post in 1983.

Strongly committed to his alma mater, Mr. Willis has served as a role model and mentor to countless young men and women both at the university and throughout Ohio. He is currently serving his second six-year term on the Varsity "O" board. Mr. Willis was instrumental in founding the Ohio State Athletic Hall of Fame and was inducted as a charter member in 1977.

His other honors include membership on the Cleveland Browns All-Time All-Star Team and in the City of Columbus and Columbus Public Schools Halls of Fame.

Ohio State is proud to recognize this man of talent, integrity, and dedication for his many contributions to youth and to the university.



ost of our us measure our lives in year-long cycles, beginning in January and ending in December. But those of us in education observe a different calendar—one in which the year-end celebration is a graduation, and the days are counted in quarters or semesters.

For college students, the cycle begins that first autumn when they arrive on campus and advances through classes and exams, vacations and summer jobs, until commencement day finally arrives. And that day comes once again as some 1,700 Ohio State Buckeyes graduate to the cheers of proud relatives and friends.

Now, these newly minted alumni will look back briefly and move on, shifting into the day-to-day rhythms of hoped-for employment. They will leave behind late nights filled with cold pizza and hot debate. No more 7:30 in the morning classes, but instead a 7:30 commute to the office. No more papers due for class, but reports due for work. They will trade their backpacks for briefcases, their ball caps for business suits.

There is no doubt that they have been changed by their college experience. Those years, whether spent at a major research university or a small, liberal arts college, represent not only a growth in knowledge but a growth in wisdom and common sense—a maturing process that prepares a student for life in the "real world." And that world does not stand still.

We need only look at the capitals of the world and the corporations of America to realize that powerful forces have been at work. During the time it has taken this most recent crop of graduates to complete their educations, the Soviet Union has come apart, Germany has come together, ethnic warfare has erupted, trade barriers have fallen, and once-mighty businesses have been brought to their knees by economic forces.

Today's graduates are being launched into a world made smaller by the media and larger by the scope of our global dilemmas: the environment, ethics, illiteracy, racism, sexism, revolution, protest, famine, and poverty.

The world is crying for the compassion and creativity of our graduates. And we need their considerable energy and ingenuity to resolve conflicts, regain civility, and restore our spirits.

That is why, for all of us, graduation is a time that renews our hope in the future. As I preside over Ohio State's commencement, I am impressed by the intelligence, dedication, and vigor of our new college graduates, young and not so young. And I feel an old, familiar feeling: optimism. Optimism about the actions our industries are taking to regain a competitive edge. Optimism about the adjustments education is making in response to a changing society. And, most of all, optimism about and faith in this new generation that is about to take its place in our society.

Today, as many of them leave school behind, their memories are bittersweet. One of Ohio State's engineering graduates sent me a letter that, I believe, captures the great joy we share in this special rite of passage and the strength of the educational process. She wrote, "There will be at least one chemical engineer with a tear in her eye as the national anthem is played, a lump in her throat as her college is introduced, a smile on her face as she gets her diploma, and a cry of joy as her father hugs her and says, 'I am so proud of you!"

It is a pride in which we can all share. I thank this graduate, and thousands like her, for all they will bring to our society. They are very bright. They work very hard. They have learned to live without security, but they continue to seek it. They are ready not only to cope with change, but to create change. And they have turned away from "me-ism" and are again seeking ways to help their fellow human beings.

I am confident that when this generation assumes leadership, America will be in very good hands.

To you, your family, friends, and those others who helped you arrive here today go our best wishes. You are joining a great family of Ohio State alumni working together to make a difference around the world.



### The Academic Costume

The colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University Commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings called for caps and floorlength capes with attached hoods, and the sobering influence of the church probably influenced the staid character of the caps and gowns.

As the control of the universities gradually passed from the church, some aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. Old prints and engravings, however, reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and that of the present day.

In the light of our nation's English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity in regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed to prepare a code for caps, gowns, and hoods that has since been adopted by all academic institutions.

Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the familiar mortarboard square—a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it covers any dress that might indicate rank or social status. The hood, reserved at The Ohio Sate University for those receiving doctoral degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the university.

### The Gown

**Bachelor.** Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves. **Master.** Black, long or short sleeves with a re-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

**Doctor.** Black with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

### The Hood

Bachelor. Three feet long with a two-inch-wide velvet edging.\*

Master. Three and one-half feet long with a three-inchwide velvet edging.\*

**Doctor.** Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet edging and panel at the sides.

\* Not usually worn by candidates for a degree.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree. The color of the velvet indicates the field of study:




