Pomp, Circumstance, and Other Songs of a Lifetime

—by David Citino, Professor of English and Creative Writing and University Poet Laureate
(Originally presented as the 2000 Winter Commencement address)

If you're like me, you've got a big head,
not to mention a funny robe, full of music—
poems and melodies, the tunes
we move to, shower and shave by,
study, write to. Not just the incidental,

but the momentous music keeping time.
Our histories are measures of song.
Listen to your heart: drums of Africa,
sea-spume of blind, far-sighted Homer,
Sappho's honeyed love lyrics. Often,

music speaks for us, one note saying
a thousand words. Like Rodolpho
in Puccini's *La Boheme*, *Sono un poeta*.
I am a poet. *Che cosa faccio?* What
do I do? *Scrivo*. I write. *This ceremony*

is loud music—pomp and circumstance
of the life you began freshman year
or that first day of graduate school.
In my head I press *Play*, and the CD
of Big Days kicks on. I leap and linger

over moments too sweet, nearly, for words.
I'll never escape rhymes from the nursery.
*Up above the world so high, like a diamond
in the sky*. We knew from the start
our universe was aglow with wonder.

Italian, Latin, English songs in nasal accents
of Cleveland. *Gaudeamus igitur, Juvenes
dum sumus*. So, let us rejoice, while
we are young. Youth is that gift we can't
comprehend while we're young. This ceremony

means you all are less young than you were.
Don't let the heavy knowledge gained
from your studies deprive you of the gifts
of youth, to be able to rejoice at the drop
of a hat, to care for, be moved by others.

Now I hear golden hits of five decades.
Big Mama Thornton, and that so-called *King*
(King of what, fried butter sandwiches?)
who stole away her hound dog. *You ain't
never killed a rabbit, you ain't no friend*

of mine. As with those profs and TAs,
course after course, you had to produce—
kill some rabbits—to earn respect.
And at times OSU may have seemed
like Heartbreak Hotel, down at the end

of Lonely Street, so difficult was it
to do your best. Tennessee Ernie Ford,
"Sixteen Tons": *St. Peter don't you
call me 'Cause I can't go. I owe
my soul to the company store*.

You have been digging deep in mines
of knowledge. We all owe our souls
to Ohio State, company store of learning,
shared experience—precious ore
we have in common forever.

Now I hear Domenico Modugno's
fervent urging to wish, sing, fly,
Volare, Wo-o-o. Cantare, Wo-o-o-o.
My grandfather was a peasant farmer,
a *contadino* in Calabria in the toe

of Italy. He knew it's the human lot
to dream of flying. *Lucky, lucky,
lucky me, I'm a lucky son-of-a-gun.*
*I work eight hours, I sleep eight hours,
That leaves eight hours for fun.*

Hey! He sailed in steerage across
the Atlantic, came to Cleveland, where
he stayed long enough to work 52 years
for the B&O Railroad, before lying down
to rest in good Ohio soil. So many of us

here today came from elsewhere,
or ancestors did. From Tennessee, Italy,
Africa, Asia, Appalachia—even,
President Kirwan, the wilds of Kentucky
and Maryland. Women and men with backs

supple as birch trunks. The courage
it took to pick up stakes and begin again
in a new world! Think of the work
those older ones did. For you. You all
are facing a change right now.

This sheepskin is your passport.
You're bound for emigration to
the next song of your life. Ohio State
is the ark on which you've been sailing.
You've been the precious cargo.

But, as Noah once said, *I can see
clearly now the rain is gone*. The ark,
our university, was filled to overflowing
with the *diversity* of us. Diversity.
Networks and talk shows devalue the word.

I say, rather, *the richness of us*,
precious difference, the grand multiplicity
of selves that balance this globe
and enable it to spin true. Grandson
of peasant immigrants, I was given

the opportunity to earn a doctorate
in English literature from Ohio State—
because my family labored long nights
around the kitchen table trying to learn
this arduous English. I sat where

you're sitting twenty-six years ago.
Bob Dylan and Smokey Robinson got me
through. Yes, it took a prophet and Miracles!
My son earned an OSU Ph.D. in history.
Now you, graduates, are being honored—

by degrees. We've all come together
around the kitchen table of Ohio State.
*Ohio, Round on the ends and high
in the middle*. For the years to come
we'll sing together, *Beautiful Ohio*,

*in dreams again I see, Visions of what
used to be*. These psalms, sacred thoughts
of our tribes, 78's and 33's, tapes,
CD's—they take up space in shelves
of our skulls, our hearts. They remind us

we want a song beyond the run-
of-the-mill thrill, the moment throbbing
with pleasure or bathed in the blues.
We ache for something grander than
pure selfishness. Songs sung for one

alone are not true music. Arias shared
are music of the spheres, ways of saying
to another something from the soul.
Of course the Buckeye Battle Cry
is there. *Drive, drive on down the field*,

*Men (and women!) of the Scarlet
and Gray*. Well, you drove on down
the field, and you drove up and down
the streets, around and around
crowded lots, looking for a place to park,

and you searched our dark, ancient library
for a decent place to study. My wife,
Mary's, father marched in the first
"Script Ohio," in 1936. He's here today
with us, blowing his horn, I can't help

but feel, as is the sweet mother
I lost last year, the one who gave me
the stars. Today's music makes us think
of the debts we owe, and never can repay.
So many of us would not be here

were it not for the lullabies and songs
of dear parents, their parents, theirs.
Some are here today in the flesh.
Many are not. We mourn them with cadences.
of our hearts. Think how many people

sang before us, gave us a name, a voice,
taught us the right words. We must
cherish them by remembering every song.
When we sing to others, we honor
our fathers and mothers, thank them

for this day of profound scarlet and gray
pomp and circumstance. O, *come
let's sing Ohio's praise, And songs
to Alma Mater raise*. Alma mater.
Ohio State is our sweet, nurturing mother.

We came of age here, with her help.
Well, Mother, we love you, but, like,
*it's time we moved out, got a place
of our own. You're standing there,
Mom, gray hair, eyes scarlet*

from crying. We won't forget you.
Now, even though this ceremony
means we're being weaned, taken off
the nipple, let's take care to cherish her
all our days. Let's remember

the words to the songs she taught us,
and pass them on. We'll remember
always, Graduation Day. *Summer's heat,
and winter's cold, The seasons pass,
the years will roll, Time and change*

will surely show How firm thy friendship,
O-hi-O. We call that little number
Carmen Ohio. *Carmen* means *song*
in Latin. You've worked hard; she
is your reward; today is your reward.

You're filled to overflowing with
the notes, the poems we've written
together. You know the score.
Continue to work hard for yourselves,
and one another. Find the ones who need

you to sing to, for them, in the world.
Graduates, this joyful litany, this hymn
our ancestors collaborated on with us,
the calling of your name today is music
to our ears. Sing that name proudly

all your days, as if your life depended
on it. It does, you know. It has been
an honor for me to speak—and sing—
to you today. Thank you, graduates,
and, again, Congratulations.

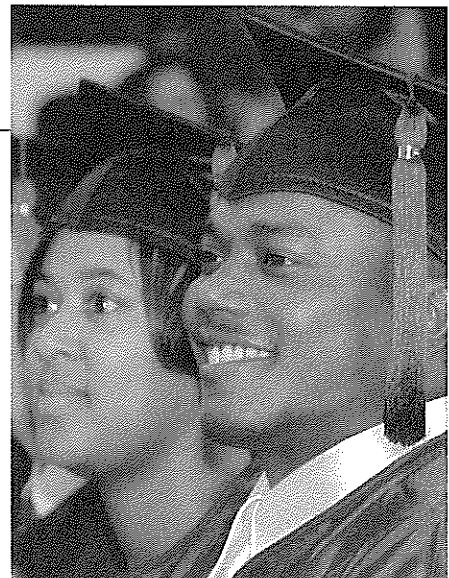

Louis W. Sullivan

Doctor of Public Health

Louis W. Sullivan is founding dean and president emeritus of Morehouse School of Medicine in Atlanta, Georgia, and former Secretary of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

A native of Atlanta, Dr. Sullivan graduated *magna cum laude* from Morehouse College's premedical program in 1954. He earned his medical degree from Boston University School of Medicine in 1958, graduating third in his class. Following fellowships in internal medicine and hematology, he joined the medical faculty of Boston University where he founded the Boston University Hematology Service at Boston City Hospital in 1967 and directed the Boston Sickle Cell Center.

Dr. Sullivan returned to Atlanta in 1975 to become the founding dean

and director of the Medical Education Program at Morehouse College, a historically black institution. Over the next three years, Dr. Sullivan and colleagues planned for a new medical school, and, in 1978, the College of Medicine at Morehouse College enrolled its first 24 students in a two-year program. In 1981, the Morehouse College of Medicine became independent from Morehouse College and was fully accredited as a four-year medical school with Dr. Sullivan as dean and president. The school's mission is to recruit and train students as physicians, biomedical scientists, and public health professionals committed to the primary health care needs of the underserved.

In 1989, Dr. Sullivan was tapped by President George H.W. Bush as the nation's 17th U.S. Secretary of Health

and Human Services. His 47-month tenure in that position was the second longest in the history of the office. As secretary, he championed America's vulnerable populations and was a strong advocate for increased medical research pertaining to racial and ethnic minorities.

Dr. Sullivan returned to Morehouse School of Medicine in 1993, continuing to serve as president until his July 1, 2002, retirement. He continues to serve on the school's board of trustees.

His many other board memberships include the Boy Scouts of America, Little League, The Ida Cason Callaway Foundation, Medical Education for South African Blacks, Africare, the Southern Center for International Studies, the Association of Minority Health Professions Schools, and the editorial board of *Minority Health Today*.

RECIPIENTS OF HONORS

Charles A. Ballard

Doctor of Public Service

Charles A. Ballard is founder and CEO of the Institute for Responsible Fatherhood and Family Revitalization in Largo, Maryland.

A native of Alabama, Mr. Ballard received his undergraduate degree in sociology/psychology from Oakwood College in Huntsville, Alabama, and a master's degree in social services administration from Case Western Reserve University's Mandel School of Applied Social Science. He continued his training in 1992 at the National Leadership Development Institute, National Center for Neighborhood Enterprise, in Washington, D.C.

In 1976, he began his pioneering studies at Cleveland Metropolitan Hospital on the issues and problems affecting men who father children despite high-risk circumstances, such

as substance abuse, poor health, history of crime and violence, lack of education, and unemployment. Over the next two years, he conducted extensive research on 400 fathers, creating a service model, called Teen Father Program: A Family Service, for fathers aged 13 through 21. From this organization, he founded the Institute for Responsible Fatherhood and Family Revitalization in 1982. The institute now has nine regional centers nationwide.

Since its inception, the institute has served more than 6,000 fathers and their families and has had a high degree of success in helping young, non-custodial fathers develop the stability and skills required for responsible parenthood. For the past two years, the United States Department

of Labor has named it the lead agency in placing fathers in unsubsidized employment under the department's Welfare-to-Work programs.

Mr. Ballard is nationally recognized as an advocate for the dignity of fatherhood and has received a number of honors, including the Martin Luther King Jr. Humanitarian Award from Cleveland's Western Reserve Historical Society; the Fatherhood Movement – Call to Action Award from the Center for the American Experiment in Minneapolis, Minnesota; Alumnus of the Year Award from Case Western Reserve's Mandel School; and the Achievement Medallion, presented by President Bush at the White House. He has appeared on "The Oprah Winfrey Show," "Eye on America," and "Good Morning America."

Howard E. LeFevre

Doctor of Humane Letters

A 70-year veteran of the trucking industry, Howard E. LeFevre is founder and retired chair and CEO of B&L Motor Freight, Inc., now known as United Carriers, Inc.

Mr. LeFevre graduated from The Ohio State University in 1929 with a degree in architectural engineering. As a longtime supporter of civic and community projects, especially in Licking County, he was the major force behind the establishment, development, and success of The Ohio State University at Newark. In 1957, he led the first fund-raising campaign for the planned campus and later helped raise \$3 million to purchase land for the Newark Campus. He and his late wife, Catherine Bonner LeFevre, a graduate of Ohio State's College of Education, made the lead gift in the 1988 Newark Campus

Endowment Campaign. He continues to play a leading role in helping to raise funds for Ohio State Newark's Center for Emerging Technologies. He serves on the Newark Campus Campaign Board and is chair emeritus of the Newark Campus Development Fund Board. In 1993, the Newark Campus named LeFevre Hall in his honor.

In 1994, he founded the Institute of Industrial Technology in Newark, a museum dedicated to Licking County's manufacturing history. Now called "The Works," the museum has been expanded to include a glass studio, art gallery, teaching studio, and digital computer laboratory and is engaged in education for all ages. In honor of his many contributions to the quality of life in Newark, Mr. LeFevre was named Newark's Man of the Century

in August 2002.

A founding member of The Presidents Club, Mr. LeFevre remains committed to strengthening Ohio State as a whole. He served on the National Campaign Committee for the university's 1985–90 campaign and on the Alumni Advisory Board. He established the Howard E. LeFevre '29 Fellowship at the Austin E. Knowlton School of Architecture and has supported the WOSU stations and the Department of Athletics. In recognition of his many years of leadership and support, he has been the recipient of Ohio State's most prestigious awards: the Alumni Centennial Award in 1970, the Distinguished Service Award in 1976, the Ralph Davenport Mershon Award in 1986, and the Everett D. Reese Medal in 1999.

RECIPIENTS OF HONORS

Joan R. Leitzel

Distinguished Service Award

Joan R. Leitzel, president emeritus of the University of New Hampshire, made lasting contributions to the academic excellence of The Ohio State University during her 25-year tenure as a member of the Department of Mathematics faculty.

After earning her B.A. from Hanover College in 1958, her M.A. from Brown University in 1961, and her Ph.D. from Indiana University in 1965—all in mathematics—she joined Ohio State as an assistant professor of mathematics. She served as vice chair of the department from 1973 to 1979 and was named full professor in 1984. In 1985, she became the university's associate provost, working directly with three successive provosts during a period of remarkable change at Ohio State.

As associate provost, she oversaw the initial steps of the university's transition to selective admissions, its increased

attention to honors students and programs, and the development and implementation of a new undergraduate curriculum. Her skillful leadership during this period helped enable the adoption and implementation of all three initiatives, all of which remain a fundamental part of the university today.

Her commitment to improved mathematics and science education also had a major impact on her academic department as she worked to improve the articulation between the university's introductory math courses and the existing K-12 curricula. She worked closely with the College of Education to design courses to prepare the next generation of math teachers, and those courses continue today. In addition, she continued to serve on major committees within the Department of Mathematics and on more than 20 major university-

level committees. Her service was recognized in 1980 with the university's Rosalene Sedgwick Award for Service to the Arts and Sciences, and, in 1982, she was awarded Ohio State's prestigious Alumni Distinguished Teaching Award.

In 1990, she was appointed director of the Division of Materials Development, Research, Information Science Education at the National Science Foundation where she was responsible for initiating and supporting science, mathematics, and technology education projects. In 1992, she assumed the position of senior vice chancellor for academic affairs at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. In 1996, she was named president of the University of New Hampshire, retiring in July 2002. She currently chairs the Mathematical Sciences Education Board of the National Research Council at the National Academy of Sciences.

Barbara C. Trueman

Distinguished Service Award

Barbara C. Trueman is owner of Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course and majority owner of TrueSports, Inc., which she founded with her late husband, Jim Trueman. Following her husband's death in 1986, she continued to manage their businesses, which included Red Roof Inns, continuing the tradition of good corporate management and growth. She sold Red Roof Inns in 1993.

A 1961 graduate of Ohio State's College of Education, Ms. Trueman is a longtime supporter of her alma mater and, in particular, its College of Veterinary Medicine. Her strong love of animals and her recognition of the care given her horses at Ohio State's Veteri-

nary Medicine Hospital led her to fund the Barbara Trueman Chair in Equine Medicine and Science, the first endowed chair in the 115-year history of the college.

As a member of the College of Veterinary Medicine's Development Advisory Council, Ms. Trueman has taken a leadership role, becoming instrumental in planning for the college's advancement. Because of her example, three more endowed funds were established in veterinary medicine following the endowment of the Trueman Chair.

Her extraordinary service to Ohio State encompasses the entire university. She has served on The Ohio State

University Foundation Board since 1994 and was a member of the National Campaign Executive Committee during the university's successful "Affirm Thy Friendship" campaign. She is a member of the Wexner Center for the Arts' board of trustees and has served on the National Council for Ohio State Women.

Ms. Trueman is also a dedicated and sought-after community volunteer, serving as a director at the Columbus Zoo, Recreation Unlimited, the Greater Columbus Convention Center, and the Columbus Museum of Art. Her past service includes membership on the boards of the J.M. Smucker Company, Bank One, and Children's Hospital.

Richard I. Wells

Distinguished Service Award

Richard I. Wells is a consultant to Prudent Rx, Inc., a prescription drug benefit consulting and pharmacy auditing company.

A 1956 graduate of Ohio State's College of Pharmacy, Mr. Wells began his service to Ohio State as an undergraduate. He was editor of the 1954 *Makio* and the College of Pharmacy student publication, *The Spur*; an officer of Ohio Staters and the Ohio Union board; and a member of the senior honorary, Sphinx.

After several years as a pharmacist in Cleveland and Los Angeles, Mr. Wells became interested in mail-order dispensing of prescriptions. In 1974, he founded Prescription Health Services, a California-based firm that pioneered the use of money-saving generic drugs and managed-care pharmacy services nationwide. Following the sale of the company in 1991, he founded Managed

Care Consultants in Los Angeles, serving as its president.

A resident of Los Angeles for the past 40 years, Mr. Wells has retained close ties to his alma mater. When Ohio State opened its Western States Regional Development Office, he provided office space, assistance, and encouragement. He has been a member of the National Major Gift Committee for the Western States since 1995 and currently serves as Ohio State's director of the Big Ten Club of Southern California. As a lifetime member of the Alumni Association, he often hosts special events for alumni in Southern California. He is a charter member of the College of Pharmacy's Dean's Corporate Council and is active in the Pharmacy Alumni Association.

His generosity and wide-ranging interests at Ohio State have resulted in an endowed scholarship fund in the

College of Humanities to support study abroad opportunities for humanities majors, an endowed scholarship in the Office of Financial Aid for student support, and the Raphael A. Wells Memorial Scholarship in the College of Pharmacy, in honor of his late brother, a 1945 Ohio State pharmacy alumnus. His support also extends to Parkinson's research, cancer research at the Arthur G. James Cancer Hospital and Richard J. Solove Research Institute, Ohio State's wetlands project, and the John Glenn Institute for Public Service and Public Policy.

Mr. Wells' dedication and service have been recognized at Ohio State with the College of Pharmacy Distinguished Alumni Award, the Ohio State Alumni Association Citizenship Award, and the John B. Gerlach Sr. Development Volunteer Award.

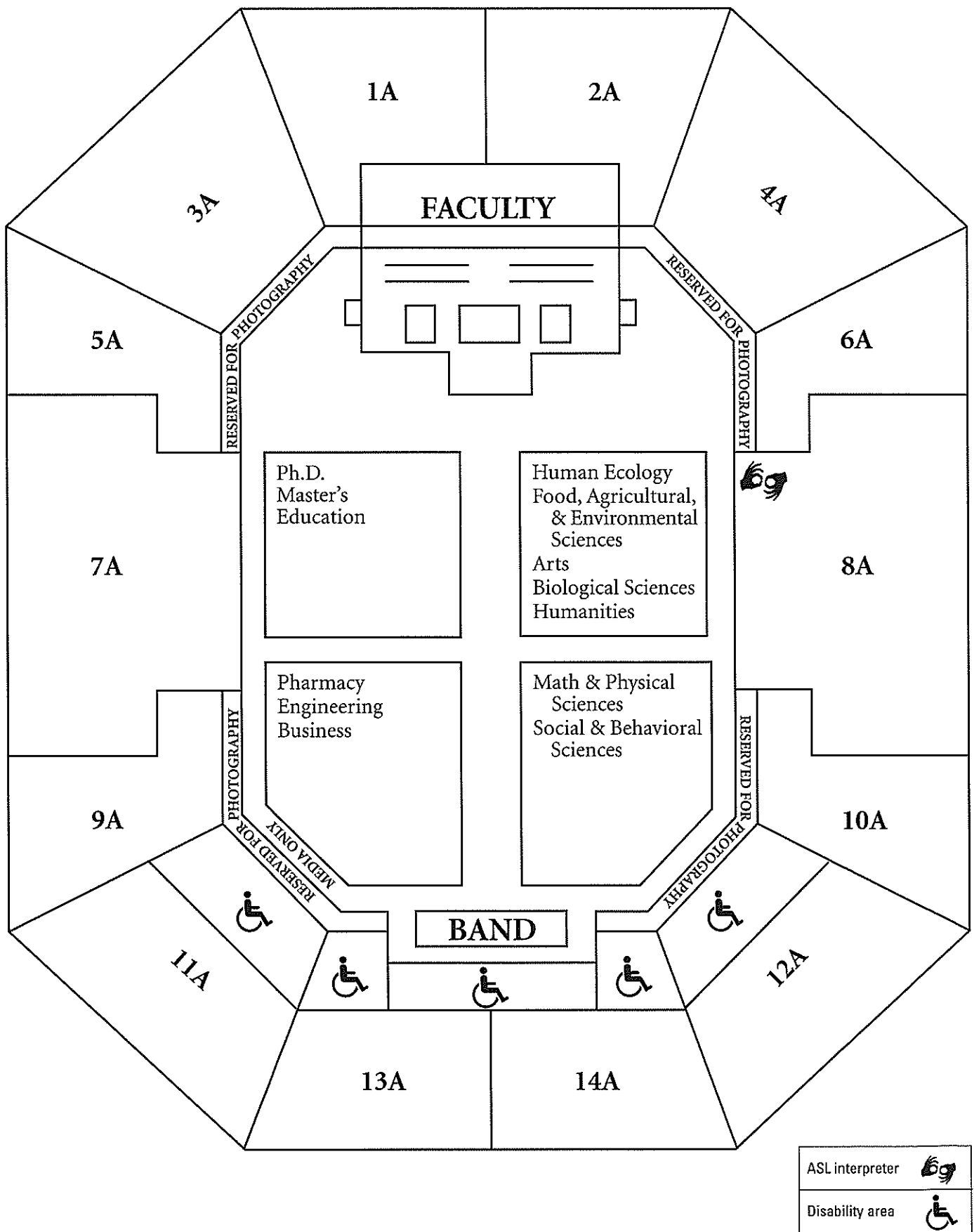

THE ACADEMIC COSTUME

The colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University commencement derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings called for caps and floor-length capes with attached hoods, and the sobering influence of the church probably influenced the staid character of the caps and gowns.

As the control of the universities gradually passed from the church, some

aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. Old prints and engravings, however, reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and that of the present day.

In light of our nation's English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity in regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed to prepare a code for caps, gowns, and hoods that has since been adopted by all academic institutions.

Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the familiar mortarboard

square—a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it covers any dress that might indicate rank or social status. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctoral and master's degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the university.

The Gown

Bachelor: The bachelor gown is black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master: The master gown is black, long or short sleeves, with an arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor: The Doctor of Philosophy gown is scarlet with gray velvet panels on the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Other doctor gowns are black with velvet panels and bars, the color of which is distinctive of the field of study.

Honors Emblem

The Ohio State University honors emblem is a scarlet and gray tasseled braid worn over the gown. Students eligible for this curricular honor are those graduating *summa cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, *cum laude*, with distinction, with honors in business, with honors in the liberal arts, and with honors in pharmacy.

The Hood

Bachelor: Three feet long with a two-inch-wide velvet edging.*

Master: Three and one-half feet long with a three-inch-wide velvet edging.

Doctor: Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet edging and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree. The color of the velvet indicates the field of study:
