

# Pomp, Circumstance, and Other Songs of a Lifetime

----by David Citino, Professor of English and Creative Writing and University Poet Laureate (Originally presented as the 2000 Winter Commencement address)

If you're like me, you've got a big head, not to mention a funny robe, full of music—poems and melodies, the tunes we move to, shower and shave by, study, write to. Not just the incidental,

but the momentous music keeping time. Our histories are measures of song. Listen to your heart: drums of Africa, sea-spume of blind, far-sighted Homer, Sappho's honeyed love lyrics. Often,

music speaks for us, one note saying a thousand words. Like Rodolpho in Puccini's La Boheme, Sono un poeta. I am a poet. Che cosa faccio? What do I do? Scrivo. I write. This ceremony

is loud music—pomp and circumstance of the life you began freshman year or that first day of graduate school. In my head I press *Play*, and the CD of Big Days kicks on. I leap and linger

over moments too sweet, nearly, for words. I'll never escape rhymes from the nursery. Up above the world so high, like a diamond in the sky. We knew from the start our universe was aglow with wonder.

Italian, Latin, English songs in nasal accents of Cleveland. Gaudeanus igitur, Juvenes dum sumus. So, let us rejoice, while we are young. Youth is that gift we can't comprehend while we're young. This ceremony

means you all are less young than you were. Don't let the heavy knowledge gained from your studies deprive you of the gifts of youth, to be able to rejoice at the drop of a hat, to care for, be moved by others.

Now I hear golden hits of five decades. Big Mama Thornton, and that so-called King (King of what, fried butter sandwiches?) who stole away her hound dog. You ain't never killed a rabbit, you ain't no friend

of mine. As with those profs and TAs, course after course, you had to produce kill some rabbits—to earn respect. And at times OSU may have seemed like Heartbreak Hotel, down at the end

of Lonely Street, so difficult was it to do your best. Tennessee Ernie Ford, "Sixteen Tons": St. Peter don't you call me 'Cause I can't go. I owe my soul to the company store. You have been digging deep in mines of knowledge. We all owe our souls to Ohio State, company store of learning, shared experience—precious ore we have in common forever.

Now I hear Domenico Modugno's fervent urging to wish, sing, fly, Volare, Wo-oo. Cantare, Wo-o-o-o. My grandfather was a peasant farmer, a contadino in Calabria in the toe

of Italy. He knew it's the human lot to dream of flying. Lucky, lucky, lucky me, I'm a lucky son-of-a-gun. I work eight hours, I sleep eight hours, That leaves eight hours for fun.

Hey! He sailed in steerage across the Atlantic, came to Cleveland, where he stayed long enough to work 52 years for the B&O Railroad, before lying down to rest in good Ohio soil. So many of us

here today came from elsewhere, or ancestors did. From Tennessee, Italy, Africa, Asia, Appalachia—even, President Kirwan, the wilds of Kentucky and Maryland. Women and men with backs

supple as birch trunks. The courage it took to pick up stakes and begin again in a new world! Think of the work those older ones did. For you, You all are facing a change right now.

This sheepskin is your passport. You're bound for emigration to the next song of your life. Ohio State is the ark on which you've been sailing. You've been the precious cargo.

But, as Noah once said, I can see clearly now the rain is gone. The ark, our university, was filled to overflowing with the diversity of us. Diversity. Networks and talk shows devalue the word,

I say, rather, the richness of us, precious difference, the grand multiplicity of selves that balance this globe and enable it to spin true, Grandson of peasant immigrants, I was given

the opportunity to earn a doctorate in English literature from Ohio State because my family labored long nights around the kitchen table trying to learn this arduous English. I sat where you're sitting twenty-six years ago. Bob Dylan and Smokey Robinson got me through. Yes, it took a prophet and Miracles! My son earned an OSU Ph.D. in history. Now you, graduates, are being honored—

by degrees. We've all come together around the kitchen table of Ohio State. Ohio, Round on the ends and high in the middle. For the years to come we'll sing together, Beautiful Ohio,

in dreams again I see, Visions of what used to be. These psalms, sacred thoughts of our tribes, 78's and 33's, tapes, CD's—they take up space in shelves of our skulls, our hearts. They remind us

we want a song beyond the runof-the-mill thrill, the moment throbbing with pleasure or bathed in the blues. We ache for something grander than pure selfishness. Songs sung for one

alone are not true music. Arias shared are music of the spheres, ways of saying to another something from the soul. Of course the Buckeye Battle Cry is there. Drive, drive on down the field,

Men (and women!) of the Scarlet and Gray. Well, you drove on down the field, and you drove up and down the streets, around and around crowded lots, looking for a place to park,

and you searched our dark, ancient library for a decent place to study. My wife, Mary's, father marched in the first "Script Ohio," in 1936. He's here today with us, blowing his horn, I can't help

but feel, as is the sweet mother I lost last year, the one who gave me the stars. Today's music makes us think of the debts we owe, and never can repay. So many of us would not be here

were it not for the lullabyes and songs of dear parents, their parents, theirs. Some are here today in the flesh. Many are not. We mourn them with cadences. of our hearts. Think how many people

sang before us, gave us a name, a voice, taught us the right words. We must cherish them by remembering every song. When we sing to others, we honor our fathers and mothers, thank them for this day of profound scarlet and gray pomp and circumstance. O, come let's sing Ohio's praise, And songs to Alma Mater raise. Alma mater. Ohio State is our sweet, nurturing mother.

We came of age here, with her help. Well, Mother, we love you, but, like, it's time we moved out, got a place of our own. You're standing there, Mom, gray hair, eyes scarlet

from crying. We won't forget you. Now, even though this ceremony means we're being weaned, taken off the nipple, let's take care to cherish her all our days. Let's remember

the words to the songs she taught us, and pass them on. We'll remember always, Graduation Day. Summer's heat, and winter's cold, The seasons pass, the years will roll, Time and change

will surely show How firm thy friendship, O-hi-O. We call that little number Carmen Ohio. Carmen means song in Latin. You've worked hard; she is your reward; today is your reward.

You're filled to overflowing with the notes, the poems we've written together. You know the score. Continue to work hard for yourselves, and one another. Find the ones who need

you to sing to, for them, in the world. Graduates, this joyful litany, this hynin our ancestors collaborated on with us, the calling of your name today is music to our ears. Sing that name proudly

all your days, as if your life depended on it. It does, you know. It has been an honor for me to speak—and sing to you today. Thank you, graduates, and, again, Congratulations.



## M. Marnette Perry

Marnette Perry is senior vice president of The Kroger Company, one of the nation's largest retail grocery chains with more than 2,500 stores in 32 states.

Ms. Perry joined Kroger in 1972 as a part-time cashier in Portsmouth, Ohio, while attending Ohio University. During her 31-year career with the company, she has held numerous roles of increasing responsibility and achieved many "firsts." In 1997, she was promoted to president of Kroger's Michigan division, becoming the first woman in the company's history to lead a retail division. Three years later,

she was named president of Kroger's Columbus division.

In March 2003, Ms. Perry was named group vice president for perishable products and moved to company headquarters in Cincinnati. She was promoted to senior vice president in July with responsibility for seven of Kroger's 17 retail divisions.

Ms. Perry is a member of the Ohio University Board of Trustees and a former member of the Central Michigan University Board of Trustees. She has also served as a member of The Ohio State University Medical Center Planning Group, and on the boards of the Columbus Association for the Performing Arts (CAPA), Columbus Chamber of Commerce, Columbus Downtown Development Corp., and the United Way of Columbus. She also served on the Foundation Board of Children's Hospital.

During her career, Ms. Perry has received numerous professional awards. In 2000, she received the "Grant Thornton Executive Women of the Year" award in Detroit. She was also named a YWCA "Career Woman of Achievement" in both Cincinnati and Detroit.

## Gerardus 't Hooft

Doctor of Science

obel laureate Gerardus 't Hooft has been professor of physics at the University of Utrecht in The Netherlands since 1977.

Born into a family of scientists, Professor 't Hooft grew up in The Hague. His granduncle, Frits Zernike, won the 1953 Nobel Prize for Physics, and his uncle, Nicholas Godfried van Kampen, was professor of theoretical physics at the University of Utrecht. Professor 't Hooft received his doctorate in theoretical physics in 1972 from the University of Utrecht.

Beginning with his thesis work in the 1970s, Professor 't Hooft has gained an international reputation as one of the most influential particle theorists in history, playing a leading role in the renaissance of high-energy physics in the late 20th century. In 1999, he and his thesis advisor, Martinus Veltman, won the Nobel Prize in physics for their work establishing the standard model of high-energy physics. His continuing work on string theory and black holes continues to inspire many advances aimed at quantizing gravity. He has authored more than 175 scholarly works in scientific books and journals.

Professor 't Hooft has been a member of the Dutch Academy of Sciences since 1982 and has received a number of other awards, including the 1979 Dannie Heineman Prize from the American Physical Society and the 1982 Wolf Prize for his work on renormalizing gauge theories. He is a foreign associate of the U.S. National Academy of Sciences and an honorary member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.

Internationally sought as a visiting lecturer, Professor 't Hooft has visited Ohio State's Department of Physics several times and gave the 2000 Alpheus Smith lecture. He has also been a guest lecturer or visiting professor at Harvard, Stanford, Boston, and Duke universities and the California Institute of Technology.

# Nathaniel R. Jones Doctor of Laws

he Honorable Nathaniel R. Jones retired as judge of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit in 2002, having been appointed by President Jimmy Carter in 1979. He now serves as senior counsel for Blank Rome LLP in Cincinnati.

A native of Youngstown, Judge Jones received his A.B. in 1951 and his L.L.B. in 1956 from Youngstown State University. Following graduation, he was executive director of the Youngstown Fair Employment Practices Commission before being appointed assistant United States attorney for the Northern District of Ohio in Cleveland, a position he held from 1960 to 1967. In 1967 he was named assistant general counsel to President Johnson's National Advisory Commission on Civil Disorders, also known

as the Kerner Commission, investigating the urban riots of the 1960s. In 1969, he began a 10-year tenure as general counsel of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP).

While with the NAACP, Judge Jones coordinated the attack against segregation in northern schools, directed the legal response to attacks on affirmative action, led an inquiry into discrimination against African American servicemen, and supervised the NAACP's defense in the Mississippi boycott case. The Mississippi case led to a landmark Supreme Court decision that officially recognized the First Amendment rights of individuals and organizations to engage in protests.

During his 23 years as a federal judge,

he frequently addressed the themes of the relationship of American justice and the American legal system to minority concerns. In addition, he gained international renown as a civil rights activist, playing an important role in abolishing apartheid in South Africa.

Judge Jones has authored numerous legal publications and is the recipient of many honors and awards, including the Ohio Bar Medal from the Ohio State Bar Association, the 2002 Thurgood Marshall Award from the National Bar Association's Judicial Council, and induction into the National Bar Association Hall of Fame. In February 2003, the U.S. Congress passed a joint resolution officially naming the Nathaniel R. Jones Federal Building and United States Courthouse in Youngstown.

## Mark B. Rucker

Doctor of Music

aritone Mark B. Rucker has earned an international reputation as a performer in some of opera's most challenging roles.

When the Chicago native sang the role of Renato in Verdi's *Un ballo in maschera* with Luciano Pavarotti for the Opera Company of Philadelphia, *Opera* magazine called him "a major addition to the ranks of genuine Verdi baritones." As winner of the second Pavarotti Competition in 1986, Mr. Rucker was seen not only in the Philadelphia production, but also in the PBS telecast of the opera later that season. Since then, he has performed to high praise in a large repertoire throughout North and South America, as well as Europe and Asia.

Mr. Rucker's New York debut was the title role in *Rigoletto* for New York City Opera. He also sang the title role in a new production of *Rigoletto* for his Netherlands Opera debut, made his Vienna Staatsoper debut as Alfio in *Cavalleria Rusticana*, and sang the title role in *Nabucco* for two consecutive summers at the Bregenz Festival.

His debut in Germany was the role of Amonasro in Aïda on tour for the Arena di Verona. Mr. Rucker sang the same role in Dublin, which was recorded on CD and released on the Naxos label. He has also recorded Gomes' Fosca with Opera Ebony and an Anthology of Songs by Lena McLin, and he has appeared as guest soloist with the Baltimore

Symphony, the Detroit Symphony, the Chicago Civic Orchestra, Des Moines Symphony, and the San Francisco Opera Orchestra.

Mr. Rucker is an active participant in helping to train aspiring opera performers and recommending them for performance opportunities. During an appearance as Scarpia in an Opera Columbus production of *Tosca*, he agreed to teach a vocal master class in Ohio State's School of Music. After becoming involved with the American Singer's Opera Project in New York City, he recommended several Ohio State singers for acceptance to the program and has continued to promote them to opera companies, conductors, and directors.

## Norman M. Stanley

Distinguished Service Award

orman M. Stanley is retired assistant director for institutional services and personnel administration at The Ohio State University Agricultural Institute (ATI) in Wooster.

He holds a B.S., M.S., and Ph.D. from the Department of Agricultural Education at Ohio State with an emphasis on educational administration. After receiving his doctorate in 1973, he was named an administrative assistant to Jerry Halterman, the founding director of ATI, then in its planning stages. In 1976, Dr. Stanley was named assistant director for institutional services and personnel administration, a post he held until his 2001 retirement.

During his tenure at ATI, Dr. Stanley planned and coordinated the construction of five major building programs val-

ued at \$15 million. He coordinated the construction of a \$5 million conference center and a \$1.2 million equine center, and he was responsible for the oversight of a 55-acre main campus and an 1800-acre farm/laboratory including swine, beef, crops, dairy, and horse enterprises. He was responsible for supervising the staff functions of finance, purchasing, personnel, public safety, plant operation and maintenance, planning, inventory, and farm operations.

Through his active membership in the Wooster Area Chamber of Commerce, Dr. Stanley was instrumental in bringing thousands of business, industry, and community leaders to the ATI campus. As campus judicial officer, he counseled and coached troubled students. He played leading roles in developing the international program at ATI and the campus interfaith program. With a strong commitment to agricultural education worldwide, he twice served as a consultant for the Midwestern University Consortium in International Activities (MUCIA) in the Dominican Republic, and he conducted a three-week study tour to Ecuador regarding an AID Rural Development Project.

His service to Ohio State has been recognized with the university's Distinguished Staff Award, the National Institute of Staff and Development Excellence Award, the ATI Outstanding Staff Award, and the College of Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences Distinguished Alumni Award.

# Charles C. Warner Distinguished Service Award

harles C. Warner is a partner in the Columbus law firm Porter, Wright, Morris & Arthur where he serves as revenue management partner and claims counsel and loss prevention coordinator.

After receiving his undergraduate education at Yale University, Mr. Warner served in the Peace Corps before enrolling in Ohio State's College of Law, where he was chief justice of the Moot Court Governing Board and a member of the National Moot Court Team, earning his J.D. cum laude in 1970.

A member of the Moritz College of Law National Alumni Advisory Council since 1994, Mr. Warner became president of the council in 2002. Since then, he has taken the lead in creating the Robert J. Nordstrom Designated Professorship, honoring a former faculty member, by soliciting former Moritz Law alumni at Porter Wright. In addition, he has created a plan for increasing annual giving to the law school by implementing a class agent and peer solicitation plan that is now underway for six pilot classes.

He and his firm have played an active role in recruitment and placement activities in the College of Law and are full participants in the Columbus Bar Association's Minority Clerkship Program, designed to enhance placement

opportunities for the city's minority law students. As president of the Columbus Bar Association in 1991-1992, Mr. Warner helped promote and expand this program, now a model for bar associations throughout the nation.

He has provided advice and counsel to three Ohio State presidents as a member of the university's Alumni Advisory Council, often serving as a facilitator for group discussions. He has also served as president of the Law Alumni Society, where he chaired a successful moot court reunion, and as a member of the dean search committee for the Moritz College of Law.





### THE ACADEMIC COSTUME

he colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings called for caps and floor-length capes with attached hoods, and the sobering influence of the church probably influenced the staid character of the caps and gowns.

As the control of the universities gradually passed from the church, some

aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. Old prints and engravings, however, reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and that of the present day.

In light of our nation's English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity in regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed to prepare a code for caps, gowns, and hoods that has since been adopted by all academic institutions.

Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the familiar mortarboard

square—a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it covers any dress that might indicate rank or social status. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctoral and master's degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the university.

#### The Gown

Bachelor: The bachelor gown is black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master: The master gown is black, long or short sleeves, with an arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor: The Ohio State University Doctor of Philosophy gown is scarlet with gray velvet panels on the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Other doctor gowns are black with velvet panels and bars, the color of which is distinctive of the field of study.

#### **Honors Emblem**

The Ohio State University honors emblem is a scarlet and gray tasseled braid worn over the gown. Students eligible for this curricular honor are those graduating *summa cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, *cum laude*, with distinction, and with honors.

#### The Hood

Bachelor: Three feet long with a two-inch-wide velvet edging.\* Master: Three and one-half feet long with a three-inch-wide velvet edging.

**Doctor:** Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet edging and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree. The color of the velvet indicates the field of study:






