

Pomp, Circumstance, and Other Songs of a Lifetime

—by David Citino, Professor of English and Creative Writing and University Poet Laureate (Originally presented as the 2000 Winter Commencement address)

If you're like me, you've got a big head, not to mention a funny robe, full of music—poems and melodies, the tunes we move to, shower and shave by, study, write to. Not just the incidental,

but the momentous music keeping time. Our histories are measures of song. Listen to your heart: drums of Africa, sea-spume of blind, far-sighted Homer, Sappho's honeyed love lyrics. Often,

music speaks for us, one note saying a thousand words. Like Rodolpho in Puccini's La Boheme, Sono un poeta. I am a poet. Che cosa faccio? What do I do? Scrivo. I write. This ceremony

is loud music—pomp and circumstance of the life you began freshman year or that first day of graduate school. In my head I press *Play*, and the CD of Big Days kicks on. I leap and linger

over moments too sweet, nearly, for words. I'll never escape rhymes from the nursery. Up above the world so high, like a diamond in the sky. We knew from the start our universe was aglow with wonder.

Italian, Latin, English songs in nasal accents of Cleveland. Gaudeanus igitur, Juvenes dum sunus. So, let us rejoice, while we are young. Youth is that gift we can't comprehend while we're young. This ceremony

means you all are less young than you were. Don't let the heavy knowledge gained from your studies deprive you of the gifts of youth, to be able to rejoice at the drop of a hat, to care for, be moved by others.

Now I hear golden hits of five decades. Big Mama Thornton, and that so-called King (King of what, fried butter sandwiches?) who stole away her hound dog. You ain't never killed a rabbit, you ain't no friend

of mine. As with those profs and TAs, course after course, you had to produce kill some rabbits—to earn respect, And at times OSU may have seemed like Heartbreak Hotel, down at the end

of Lonely Street, so difficult was it to do your best. Tennessee Ernie Ford, "Sixteen Tons": St. Peter don't you call me 'Cause I can't go. I owe my soul to the company store. You have been digging deep in mines of knowledge. We all owe our souls to Ohio State, company store of learning, shared experience—precious ore we have in common forever.

Now I hear Domenico Modugno's fervent urging to wish, sing, fly, Volare, Wo-o- Cantare, Wo-o-o-o. My grandfather was a peasant farmer, a contadino in Calabria in the toe

of Italy. He knew it's the human lot to dream of hying. Lucky, lucky, lucky me, I'm a lucky son-of-a-gun. I work eight hours, I sleep eight hours, That leaves eight hours for fun.

Hey! He sailed in steerage across the Atlantic, came to Cleveland, where he stayed long enough to work 52 years for the B&O Railroad, before lying down to rest in good Ohio soil. So many of us

here today came from elsewhere, or ancestors did. From Tennessee, Italy, Africa, Asia, Appalachia—even, President Kirwan, the wilds of Kentucky and Maryland. Women and men with backs

supple as birch trunks. The courage it took to pick up stakes and begin again in a new world! Think of the work those older ones did. For you You all are facing a change right now.

This sheepskin is your passport. You're bound for emigration to the next song of your life. Ohio State is the ark on which you've been sailing. You've been the precious cargo.

But, as Noah once said, I can see clearly now the rain is gone. The ark, our university, was filled to overflowing with the diversity of us. Diversity.

Networks and talk shows devalue the word.

I say, rather, the richness of us, precious difference, the grand multiplicity of selves that balance this globe and enable it to spin true. Grandson of peasant immigrants, I was given

the opportunity to earn a doctorate in English literature from Ohio State because my family labored long nights around the kitchen table trying to learn this arduous English. I sat where you're sitting twenty-six years ago. Bob Dylan and Smokey Robinson got me through. Yes, it took a prophet and Miracles! My son earned an OSU Ph.D. in history. Now you, graduates, are being honored—

by degrees. We've all come together around the kitchen table of Ohio State. Ohio, Round on the ends and high in the middle. For the years to come we'll sing together, Beautiful Ohio,

in dreams again I see, Visions of what used to be. These psalms, sacred thoughts of our tribes, 78's and 33's, tapes, CD's—they take up space in shelves of our skulls, our hearts. They remind us

we want a song beyond the runof-the-mill thrill, the moment throbbing with pleasure or bathed in the blues. We ache for something grander than pure selfishness. Songs sung for one

alone are not true music. Arias shared are music of the spheres, ways of saying to another something from the soul. Of course the Buckeye Battle Cry is there. Drive, drive on down the field,

Men (and women!) of the Scarlet and Gray. Well, you drove on down the field, and you drove up and down the streets, around and around crowded lots, looking for a place to park,

and you searched our dark, ancient library for a decent place to study. My wife, Mary's, father marched in the first "Script Ohio," in 1936. He's here today with us, blowing his horn, I can't help

but feel, as is the sweet mother.
I lost last year, the one who gave me the stars. Today's music makes us think of the debts we owe, and never can repay. So many of us would not be here

were it not for the fullabyes and songs of dear parents, their parents, theirs. Some are here today in the flesh. Many are not. We mourn them with cadences. of our hearts. Think how many people

sang before us, gave us a name, a voice, taught us the right words. We must cherish them by remembering every song. When we sing to others, we honor our fathers and mothers, thank them for this day of profound scarlet and gray pomp and circumstance. O, come let's sing Ohio's praise, And songs to Alma Mater raise. Alma mater. Ohio State is our sweet, nurturing moth-

We came of age here, with her help. Well, Mother, we love you, but, like, it's time we moved out, got a place of our own. You're standing there, Mom, gray hair, eyes scarlet

from crying. We won't forget you. Now, even though this ceremony means we're being weaned, taken off the nipple, let's take care to cherish her all our days. Let's remember

the words to the songs she taught us, and pass them on. We'll remember always, Graduation Day. Summer's heat, and winter's cold, The seasons pass, the years will roll, Time and change

will surely show How firm thy friendship, O-hi-O. We call that little number Carmen Ohio. Carmen means song in Latin. You've worked hard; she is your reward; today is your reward.

You're filled to overflowing with the notes, the poems we've written together. You know the score. Continue to work hard for yourselves, and one another. Find the ones who nee

you to sing to, for them, in the world. Graduates, this joyful litany, this hymn our ancestors collaborated on with us, the calling of your name today is music to our ears. Sing that name proudly

all your days, as if your life depended on it. It does, you know. It has been an honor for me to speak—and sing to you today. Thank you, graduates, and, again, Congratulations.



Deborah Jones Merritt

eborah Jones Merritt has directed The Ohio State University's John Glenn Institute for Public Service and Public Policy since 2000. Under her direction, the institute has grown to encompass more than three dozen programs encouraging students to become active citizens, enhancing the skills of public leaders, and developing

strong public policy.

In addition to directing the institute, Professor Merritt holds the John Deaver Drinko/Baker & Hostetler Chair in Law at the Moritz College of Law. She also holds courtesy appointments in Public Policy and Management, Sociology, and Women's Studies. She has taught courses for undergraduates, law students, and graduate students on public service, social science methods, constitutional law, women and law, law and poverty, law and medicine, and leadership.

Professor Merritt earned her B.A. summa cum laude in history from Harvard University and her J.D. from Columbia University. At Columbia, she served as managing editor of the Columbia Law Review, earned the distinction of James Kent Scholar, and won the Robert Noxon Toppan prize in constitutional law. After graduation, she clerked for Judge (now Justice) Ruth Bader Ginsburg on the Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit and then for Justice Sandra Day O'Connor on the Supreme Court of the United States. Professor Merritt practiced law in Atlanta, Georgia, and joined the law faculty at the University of Illinois in 1985. She served there as professor of law, professor of women's studies, advisor to the Joint J.D./M.D. Program, and associate dean for academic affairs before moving to Ohio State, where she accepted the Drinko chair in 1995.

Professor Merritt's scholarly research covers a wide variety of public policy topics, including federal-state relations, equality, affirmative action, health care, technology, and leadership development. She has spoken on these issues to legislators, judges, scholars, and policymakers around the country.

During her nine years at Ohio State, Professor Merritt has served the university on many initiatives, including the search committee for executive vice president and provost, search committee for vice president of development, outreach and engagement leadership action committee, oversight committee for the Center for Urban and Regional Analysis, policy initiative oversight committee, committee to select distinguished university professors, and ad hoc committee to create the Institute for the Study of Race and Ethnicity in the Americas (now the Kirwan Institute). She has chaired both the vice president for research's advisory committee and the university-wide affirmative action committee.

The university has recognized Professor Merritt with three of its top awards: University Distinguished Lecturer (1999), Distinguished Scholar Award (2002), and Distinguished Diversity Enhancement Award (2004).

Edward J. Larson

Doctor of Humane Letters

dward J. Larson is the Russell
Professor of History and Talmadge
Professor of Law at the University
of Georgia and recipient of the 1998
Pulitzer Prize in history. His areas of
expertise are the history of biology and
medicine, health care law, and science law.

A native of Mansfield, Ohio, Professor Larson earned a B.A. from Williams College, a J.D. from Harvard University, and a M.A. and Ph.D. in the history of science from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. Prior to joining Georgia's faculty in 1987, he served as associate counsel for the U.S. House of Representatives Committee on Education and Labor from 1983 to 1989 and as an attorney with a major Seattle law firm from 1979 to 1983.

The author of five books and more than 70 published articles, Professor Larson writes mostly about issues of science, medicine, and law from a historical perspective. His books are Evolution: The Remarkable History of a

Scientific Theory (2004); Evolution's Workshop: God and Science in the Galapagos Islands (2001); Sex, Race and Science: Eugenics in the Deep South (1995); Trial and Error: The American Controversy Over Creation and Evolution (1985, 1989, and 2002 expanded editions); and the Pulitzer Prize-winning Summer for the Gods: The Scopes Trial and America's Continuing Debate Over Science and Religion (1997). He is the coauthor or coeditor of five additional books.

Professor Larson has written numerous scholarly articles, book chapters, and other publications that have appeared in such varied journals as Nature, Atlantic Monthly, Scientific American, The Nation, Wall Street Journal, Virginia Law Review, and British Journal for the History of Science. The Fulbright Program named him to the John Adams Chair in American Studies for 2001, and he received the 2000 George Sarton Award from the American Association for the

Advancement of Science. Last year, Professor Larson participated in the National Science Foundation's acclaimed Antarctic writers program, which has ties to Ohio State's Byrd Polar Research Center.

A popular and engaging teacher, Professor Larson lectures and speaks on history, law, and bio-sciences for academic, professional, and public audiences, and he has delivered endowed or funded addresses at some 50 colleges or universities. He is interviewed frequently for broadcast and print media, including multiple appearances on PBS, the History Channel, C-SPAN, and NPR.

Professor Larson currently holds a joint appointment in the history department and law school at the University of Georgia, where he teaches the history of science to undergraduates and health, science, and technology law to law students. He is the recipient of several teaching awards and has taught in Austria, China, France, the Netherlands, and New Zealand.

Leon M. Lederman

Doctor of Science Education

n internationally renowned specialist in high-energy physics, Leon M. Lederman is director emeritus of the Fermi National Accelerator Laboratory in Batavia, Illinois, and holds an appointment as Pritzker Professor of Science at the Illinois Institute of Technology.

A native of New York, Dr. Lederman received his B.S. degree from the City College of New York in 1943 and his M.A. and Ph.D. in 1948 and 1951, respectively, from Columbia University. Following his doctorate, he joined Columbia's faculty, remaining there for the next 28 years, becoming full professor in 1958. From 1962 to 1979, he served as director of Nevis Laboratories in Irvington, New York, the Columbia Department of Physics' center for experimental research in high-energy physics.

With colleagues and students at Nevis, he led an intensive and wide-ranging series of experiments which have provided major advances in the understanding of fundamental particles. His work on neutrinos led to his recognition as a Nobel laureate in physics in 1988.

In 1979, Dr. Lederman became director of the Fermi National Accelerator Laboratory, where he supervised the construction and utilization of the Tevatron, the first super conducting synchroton, the highest energy accelerator in the world. He retired from Fermilab in 1989 to join the faculty of the University of Chicago as a professor of physics.

Long an advocate for the importance of science education, Dr. Lederman initiated more than 15 programs for audiences ranging from kindergarten and elementary school children through college teachers while at Fermilab. He was the initiator and chief organizer of the Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy, a three-year residential public school for gifted students in the state of Illinois, and, in 1998, became its inaugural Resident Scholar. He is chair emeritus of the board of the Teachers Academy for

Mathematics and Science, a universitychartered program to retrain primary school teachers of mathematics and science.

His interest in international collaboration in science led him to open Fermilab's facilities to countries not previously associated with high-energy physics, especially in Latin America. In 1997, he was appointed a Presidential Fellow by the president of the World Bank. In 2000, he co-chaired an International Conference on Primary School Science Education in Beijing. He is currently honorary president and patron of the World Academy of Young Scientists.

Dr. Lederman is a member of the National Academy of Sciences and a past president of the American Association for the Advancement of Science. He was presented the National Medal of Science by President Lyndon Johnson in 1965 and the Enrico Fermi Prize by President Bill Clinton in 1993.

M.S. Swaminathan

Doctor of Agricultural Science

S. Swaminathan is chair of the M.S. Swaminathan Research Foundation in Madras, India, and holder of the UNESCO-Cousteau Chair in Ecotechnology. He is acknowedged as the architect of the Green Revolution in India and as one of the world's leading agricultural scientists.

Born in Tamil Nadu, India, Professor Swaminathan was educated at Travancore and Madras Universities. He received his Ph.D. in genetics from Cambridge University in 1952. From 1954 to 1972, he worked at the Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi, mainly in the field of wheat improvement. He served as director general of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research; secretary of the Department of Agricultural Research and Education (1972–1979); and principal secretary of the Ministry of Agriculture and Irrigation (1979-1980).

A plant geneticist by training, Professor Swaminathan played a catalytic role in India's Green Revolution between 1960 and 1982. From April 1982 to January 1988 he served as director general of the International Rice Research Institute (IRRI). For the decade prior to assuming his post with IRRI, he was at the forefront of one of the most remarkable agricultural accomplishments in recent history—moving India from having the largest food deficit in the world to producing enough grain to feed all of its people.

For more than half a century, Professor Swaminathan has worked in collaboration with scientists and policy makers on a wide range of problems in basic and applied plant genetics and agricultural research and development. His many scientific contributions include conservation of plant genetic resources; in situ and ex situ conservation of biodiversity; manipulation of genes to improve the yield, quality, and stability of wheat, rice, and potatoes; identification of the barriers to high yields in wheat and initiation of the dwarf wheat breeding

program; and identification of cytotoxic agents in irradiated food material.

Professor Swaminathan was acclaimed by Time magazine as one of the 20 most influential Asians of the 20th century and one of only three from India, the other two being Mahatma Gandhi and Rabindranath Tagore. The International Association of Women and Development conferred on him the first international award for significant contributions to promoting the knowledge, skill, and technological empowerment of women in agriculture and for his pioneering role in mainstreaming gender considerations in agriculture and rural development. He was the recipient of the Ramon Magsaysay Award for Community Leadership in 1971, the Albert Einstein World Science Award in 1986, and the first World Food Prize in 1987. He is a fellow of many leading scientific academies, including the National Academy of Sciences and the Royal Society of London.

Donald D. Glower

Distinguished Service Award

onald D. Glower served The Ohio State University as professor, chair, dean, and vice president before his retirement in 1992.

Born in Shelby, Ohio, he received B.S. degrees from the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy and Antioch College. He earned a M.S. in mechanical engineering and a Ph.D. in nuclear engineering from Iowa State University. Following seven years of industrial experience, Dr. Glower joined the Ohio State faculty in 1964 as head of the nuclear engineering program, becoming chair of the Department of Mechanical Engineering in 1968. He became dean of the College of Engineering in 1976, serving until 1990, when he became vice president for university communications and development.

During his tenure in the College of Engineering, Dr. Glower established a number of initiatives that raised the college's national stature and nurtured long-term relationships with communities outside the university. He assumed control of the Transportation Research Center of Ohio, turning a losing state investment into the largest and most comprehensive transportation research facility in the world, attracting the Honda Corporation to build in Ohio. Honda has since established an endowment fund in the College of Engineering that supports continued improvement in the quality of academic programs.

Dr. Glower worked with the faculty to establish the Advanced Design Methods Laboratory, the Edison Welding Institute, and the Engineering Manufacturing Research Center, facilitating partnerships with leaders from private industry. He was instrumental in establishing the National Regulatory Research Institute at Ohio State, which provides state Public Utility Commissions across the nation with unbiased research information.

He pioneered the establishment of an industrial advisory committee and fund raising by individual departments, leading Ohio State's first ever collegelevel fund drive to raise \$17 million for the College of Engineering. The success of this capital campaign facilitated modernizing the college laboratories and the creation of new academic programs.

An advocate of cooperative education, Dr. Glower sought and secured funding for a program that links students with industry for important experiential learning. He attracted National Merit Scholars to the college and established offices for the recruitment and retention of women and minority students.

Dr. Glower's leadership and service over nearly three decades have enriched and strengthened not only the College of Engineering but the entire university community.

THE OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY CLASS GIFT PROGRAM

he colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings called for caps and floorlength capes with attached hoods, and the sobering influence of the church probably influenced the staid character of the caps and gowns.

As the control of the universities gradually passed from the church, some

aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. Old prints and engravings, however, reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and that of the present day.

In light of our nation's English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity in regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed to prepare a code for caps, gowns, and hoods that has since been adopted by all academic institutions.

Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the familiar mortarboard

square—a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it covers any dress that might indicate rank or social status. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctoral and master's degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the university.

The Gown

Bachelor: The bachelor gown is black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master: The master gown is black, long or short sleeves, with an arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor: The Ohio State University Doctor of Philosophy gown is scarlet with gray velvet panels on the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Other doctor gowns are black with velvet panels and bars, the color of which is distinctive of the field of study.

Honors Emblem

The Ohio State University honors emblem is a scarlet and gray tasseled braid worn over the gown. Students eligible for this curricular honor are those graduating *summa cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, *cum laude*, with distinction, and with honors.

The Hood

Bachelor: Three feet long with a two-inch-wide velvet edging.* Master: Three and one-half feet long with a three-inch-wide velvet edging.

Doctor: Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet edging and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree. The color of the velvet indicates the field of study or degree received.


Cap and Tassel
