

## POMP, CIRCUMSTANCE, AND OTHER SONGS OF A LIFETIME

-by Professor David Citino, 1947-2005, Late University Poet Laureate

(Originally presented as the 2000 Winter Commencement address)

If you're like me, you've got a big head, not to mention a funny robe, full of music—poems and melodies, the tunes we move to, shower and shave by, study, write to. Not just the incidental,

but the momentous music keeping time. Our histories are measures of song. Listen to your heart: drums of Africa, sea-spume of blind, far-sighted Homer, Sappho's honeyed love lyrics. Often,

music speaks for us, one note saying a thousand words. Like Rodolpho in Puccini's La Boheme, Sono un poeta. I am a poet. Che cosa faccio? What do I do? Scrivo. I write. This ceremony

is loud music—pomp and circumstance of the life you began freshman year or that first day of graduate school. In my head I press *Play*, and the CD of Big Days kicks on. I leap and linger

over moments too sweet, nearly, for words. I'll never escape rhymes from the nursery. Up above the world so high, like a diamond in the sky. We knew from the start our universe was aglow with wonder.

Italian, Latin, English songs in nasal accents of Cleveland. Gaudeamus igitur, Juvenes dum sumus. So, let us rejoice, while we are young. Youth is that gift we can't comprehend while we're young. This ceremony

means you all are less young than you were. Don't let the heavy knowledge gained from your studies deprive you of the gifts of youth, to be able to rejoice at the drop of a hat, to care for, be moved by others.

Now I hear golden hits of five decades. Big Mama Thornton, and that so-called King (King of what, fried butter sandwiches?) who stole away her hound dog. You ain't never killed a rabbit, you ain't no friend

of mine. As with those profs and TAs, course after course, you had to produce—kill some rabbits—to earn respect. And at times OSU may have seemed like Heartbreak Hotel, down at the end

of Lonely Street, so difficult was it to do your best. Tennessee Ernie Ford, "Sixteen Tons": St. Peter don't you call me 'Cause I can't go. I owe my soul to the company store. You have been digging deep in mines of knowledge. We all owe our souls to Ohio State, company store of learning, shared experience—precious ore we have in common forever.

Now I hear Domenico Modugno's fervent urging to wish, sing, fly, Volare, Wo-oo. Cantare, Wo-o-o-o. My grandfather was a peasant farmer, a contadino in Calabria in the toe

of Italy. He knew it's the human lot to dream of flying. Lucky, lucky, lucky me, I'm a lucky son-of-a-gun. I work eight hours, I sleep eight hours, That leaves eight hours for fun.

Hey! He sailed in steerage across the Atlantic, came to Cleveland, where he stayed long enough to work 52 years for the B&O Railroad, before lying down to rest in good Ohio soil. So many of us

here today came from elsewhere, or ancestors did. From Tennessee, Italy, Africa, Asia, Appalachia—even, President Kirwan, the wilds of Kentucky and Maryland. Women and men with backs

supple as birch trunks. The courage it took to pick up stakes and begin again in a new world! Think of the work those older ones did. For you. You all are facing a change right now.

This sheepskin is your passport. You're bound for emigration to the next song of your life. Ohio State is the ark on which you've been sailing. You've been the precious cargo.

But, as Noah once said, I can see clearly now the rain is gone. The ark, our university, was filled to overflowing with the diversity of us. Diversity. Networks and talk shows devalue the word.

I say, rather, the richness of us, precious difference, the grand multiplicity of selves that balance this globe and enable it to spin true. Grandson of peasant immigrants, I was given

the opportunity to earn a doctorate in English literature from Ohio State because my family labored long nights around the kitchen table trying to learn this arduous English. I sat where

you're sitting twenty-six years ago. Bob Dylan and Smokey Robinson got me through. Yes, it took a prophet and Miracles! My son earned an OSU Ph.D. in history. Now you, graduates, are being honored....

by degrees. We've all come together around the kitchen table of Ohio State. Ohio, Round on the ends and high in the middle. For the years to come we'll sing together, Beautiful Ohio,

in dreams again I see, Visions of what used to be. These psalms, sacred thoughts of our tribes, 78's and 33's, tapes, CD's—they take up space in shelves of our skulls, our hearts. They remind us

we want a song beyond the runof-the-mill thrill, the moment throbbing with pleasure or bathed in the blues. We ache for something grander than pure selfishness. Songs sung for one

alone are not true music. Arias shared are music of the spheres, ways of saying to another something from the soul. Of course the Buckeye Battle Cry is there. Drive, drive on down the field,

Men (and women!) of the Scarlet and Gray. Well, you drove on down the field, and you drove up and down the streets, around and around crowded lots, looking for a place to park,

and you searched our dark, ancient library for a decent place to study. My wife, Mary's, father marched in the first "Script Ohio," in 1936. He's here today with us, blowing his horn, I can't help

but feel, as is the sweet mother I lost last year, the one who gave me the stars. Today's music makes us think of the debts we owe, and never can repay. So many of us would not be here

were it not for the lullabyes and songs of dear parents, their parents, theirs. Some are here today in the flesh. Many are not. We mourn them with cadences. of our hearts. Think how many people

sang before us, gave us a name, a voice, taught us the right words. We must cherish them by remembering every song. When we sing to others, we honor our fathers and mothers, thank them

for this day of profound scarlet and gray pomp and circumstance. O, come let's sing Ohio's praise, And songs to Alma Mater raise. Alma mater. Ohio State is our sweet, nurturing mother.

We came of age here, with her help. Well, Mother, we love you, but, like, it's time we moved out, got a place of our own. You're standing there, Mom, gray hair, eyes scarlet

from crying. We won't forget you. Now, even though this ceremony means we're being weaned, taken off the nipple, let's take care to cherish her all our days. Let's remember

the words to the songs she taught us, and pass them on. We'll remember always, Graduation Day. Summer's heat, and winter's cold, The seasons pass, the years will roll, Time and change

will surely show How firm thy friendship, O-hi-O. We call that little number Carmen Ohio. Carmen means song in Latin. You've worked hard; she is your reward; today is your reward.

You're filled to overflowing with the notes, the poems we've written together. You know the score. Continue to work hard for yourselves, and one another. Find the ones who need

you to sing to, for them, in the world. Graduates, this joyful litany, this hymn our ancestors collaborated on with us, the calling of your name today is music to our ears. Sing that name proudly

all your days, as if your life depended on it. It does, you know. It has been an honor for me to speak—and sing to you today. Thank you, graduates, and, again, Congratulations.



## Deborah A. Ballam

eborah A. Ballam is associate provost for Women's Policy Initiatives and director of The Women's Place at The Ohio State University.

A four-time graduate of Ohio State, Professor Ballam earned her B.A., M.A., J.D., and Ph.D. degrees at the university, joining the faculty in 1982. She is a professor of legal environment of business in the Fisher College of Business. Before assuming the leadership role at The Women's Place, she directed the Undergraduate Business Administration Honors Program.

As director of The Women's Place, Professor Ballam oversees the university's central resource aimed at connecting and improving the quality and equality of work/life for women at Ohio State. She also serves as an advisory resource for development of university policies affecting women.

She is widely published on topics in employment law and the history of the relationship of government and business. She has served as editor-in-chief of *The American Business Law Journal* 

and as president of the Tri-State Regional of the Academy of Legal Studies in Business, which awarded her its national Senior Faculty Award for excellence in research. The academy also has presented her with two outstanding research awards for articles published in *The American Business Law Journal*.

Professor Ballam's scholarship and teaching have been recognized by Ohio State with several awards, including the University Distinguished Affirmative Action Award, the College of Business Pace Setters Outstanding Undergraduate Teaching Award, and the Association of Faculty and Professional Women's Mary Ann Williams Leadership Award.

In recognition of her commitment to women's rights, Professor Ballam was honored as one of the Franklin County YWCA Women of Achievement in 2002 and with the 2003 Nettie Cronise Lutes Award, presented by the Ohio State Bar Association for dedication to the advancement of women in the legal profession. Her proudest accomplishment, however, is her wonderful son David.

## THE JOSEPH SULLIVANT MEDAL

The Joseph Sullivant Medal was established in 1920 with a fund endowed by Thomas C. Mendenhall, Ohio State professor of physics. The Sullivant Medal is awarded every five years for "an admittedly notable achievement on the part of a son or daughter of the university, whether that achievement be in the form of an important invention, discovery, contribution to science, the practical solution of a significant engineering, economic, or agricultural problem, or the production of a valuable literary, artistic, historical, philosophical, or other work." (Thomas Mendenhall, 1920)

## Liang-Shih Fan

iang-Shih Fan is Distinguished University Professor and C. John Easton Professor of Engineering in The Ohio State University's Department of Chemical and Biomolecular Engineering. He is one of the world's leading authorities on fluidization and multiphase flow, powder technology, and energy and environmental reaction engineering.

Professor Fan earned his B.S. degree from National Taiwan University and his M.S. and Ph.D. degrees from West Virginia University, all in chemical engineering. He also earned a M.S. in statistics from Kansas State University before joining the Ohio State faculty in 1978. He served as chair of the Department of Chemical Engineering from 1994 to 2003.

During his 27 years at Ohio State, he has gained international renown for his invention of several patented clean coal processes, including "OSCAR" (Ohio State Carbonation Ash Reactivation) and "CARBONOX," (carbon-based NOx reduction technology). Both processes have been successfully demonstrated for

flue gas cleaning in coal combustion with the projected economic impact of these processes at billions of dollars globally.

In the fluidization and powder technology areas, Professor Fan developed the first Electrical Capacitance Volume-Tomography (ECTV) for real-time 3-D imaging of flow structures in multiphase flows, the impact of which is comparable in chemical processes industries to that of the CATSCAN in medical applications.

Professor Fan has authored or coauthored three books, 22 book chapters,
280 journal papers, and 240 conference
papers. He has edited 13 symposia, journal volumes, or books, and he holds 12
patents. He has served as a technical leader
in the Argonne National Laboratory Midwest Universities Consortium's Multiphase
Flow Institute and as consultant to 20
corporations and national laboratories,
including Exxon, Shell, DuPont, Union
Carbide, and the Pittsburgh Energy
Technology Center. He is an elected
member representing the United States on
the governing board of the International

Congress of the Multiphase Flows and is the founding chair of the American Institute of Chemical Engineers' Particle Technology Forum and a member of the National Science Foundation's Active Chemistry Writing Team Leader for a K-12 textbook and the National Academy of Engineering's Minority Engineering Committee.

Professor Fan has received more than 50 awards in recognition of his research and teaching, including the American Chemical Society's E.V. Murphree Award in Industrial and Engineering Chemistry, the American Institute of Chemical Engineers Alpha Xi Sigma Award for Chemical Engineering Research, the Council for Chemical Research's Malcolm E. Pruitt Award, and the American Society for Engineering Education's Union Carbide Lectureship Award. He is a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science and the American Institute of Chemical Engineers, a member of the U.S. National Academy of Engineering, and a foreign member of the Mexican Academy of Sciences.

## **Judah Folkman**

Doctor of Science

udah Folkman is Julia Dyckman Andrus Professor of Pediatric Surgery and professor of cell biology at Harvard Medical School and is currently director of the Vascular Biology Program at Children's Hospital, Boston.

A native of Columbus, he received his undergraduate degree from The Ohio State University in 1953 and his medical degree from Harvard University in 1957. From 1960 to 1962, he served as a lieutenant in the U.S. Navy at the National Naval Medical College in Bethesda, Maryland, where he and a colleague reported the use of silicone rubber implantable polymers for the sustained release of drugs. These findings led to the development of Norplant—an internationally used contraceptive—and initiated the field of controlled release technology.

Following his residency in the Department of Surgery at Massachusetts

General Hospital, Dr. Folkman joined the Harvard Medical School faculty, becoming professor of surgery in 1967. That same year, he was appointed surgeon-in-chief and chair of the Department of Surgery at Children's Hospital, Boston, a position he held for 14 years before changing his career to full-time research. During this time, he initiated the field of angiogenesis research by studying how malignant tumors develop their blood supply.

In 1971, he published an article in *The New England Journal of Medicine* advancing the hypothesis that all tumor growth is dependent on angiogenesis—the growth of new capillary blood vessels. During the next decade, Dr. Folkman developed a number of laboratory tests that could be used to study tumor angiogenesis. He isolated the first tumor angiogenic proteins in the 1980s, and, in the 1990s, he and his colleagues identified angiostatin

and endostatin, both of which are naturally occurring inhibitors of tumor angiogenesis. These discoveries have set the stage for the development of new drugs that may be even more potent inhibitors of tumor angiogenesis. Angiogenesis inhibitors have now received FDA approval in the United States for cancer and for the treatment of macular degeneration and are also approved in 27 other countries.

Dr. Folkman is the author of 391 original, peer-reviewed papers and 106 book chapters and monographs. He has been elected to the National Academy of Sciences, the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, the American Philosophical Society, and the Institute of Medicine of the National Academy of Sciences. He is also the recipient of numerous national and international awards.

## Jerome I. Friedman

Doctor of Science

obel laureate Jerome I. Friedman is Institute Professor Emeritus and Professor of Physics Emeritus at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

A native of Chicago, Professor
Friedman earned his A.B., M.S., and
Ph.D. degrees at the University of Chicago
and began his career in physics at that
institution's Enrico Fermi Institute as a
research associate in 1956. He then spent
three years at Stanford University's High
Energy Physics Laboratory before joining
the MIT faculty as an assistant professor
in 1960, becoming a full professor in
1967. From 1980 to 1983, he served as
director of MIT's Laboratory for Nuclear
Science and, from 1983 to 1988, as head
of the physics department.

Professor Friedman specializes in experimental particle physics. His

research has included studies of particle structure and interactions with high-energy electrons, neutrinos, and hadrons. His experiments at the Stanford Linear Accelerator proving the existence of quarks as the fundamental building blocks of all hadronic matter were recognized by the 1990 Nobel Prize in Physics, awarded jointly with colleagues Henry W. Kendall and Richard E. Taylor, and by the 1989 W.H.K. Panofsky Prize.

He is also the recipient of the Wick Medal of the World Federation of Scientists and the Alumni Medal of the University of Chicago. He is a member of the National Academy of Sciences, the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, and the American Philosophical Society, and a Fellow of the American Physical Society and the American Association for the Advancement of Science.

Professor Friedman has served on numerous advisory committees for the U.S. Department of Energy and various laboratories, including the Cambridge Electron Accelerator, CERN—the European multinational particle physics laboratory—the Council of the High Energy Accelerator Research Organization of Japan, Fermilab, Los Alamos National Laboratory, Princeton-Penn Accelerator, Stanford Linear Accelerator Center, the Superconducting Super Collider, and Wilson Laboratory.

He is a past president of the American Physical Society and was chair of the Council of Scientific Society Presidents. He currently serves as vice chair of the board of governors of the Okinawa Institute of Science and Technology.

## Michael E. Moritz

Distinguished Service Award

ichael E. Moritz, a dual graduate of The Ohio State University and the man for whom Ohio State's College of Law was named, died tragically in 2002. His generosity in making the largest single gift the university has ever received has resulted in unprecedented opportunities for the college and its students.

The Columbus native earned a B.S. in business administration in 1958 and his law degree in 1961, graduating at the top of his class. During his years at the law school, Mr. Moritz was supported by a \$5,000-a-year Mershon Scholarship, which he was to pay back many times over as he became a successful lawyer.

He began his law career with Dunbar,

Kienzle and Murphy and, in 1972, formed his own firm with David McClure, also an Ohio State alumnus. In 1980, the firm—by then a 12-lawyer group—merged with the Cleveland firm of Baker & Hostetler with Mr. Moritz as a partner in the Columbus office.

Mr. Moritz was a director of Cardinal Health, Pharmacy Systems, and the Pickett Hotel Company. He was a past president of the Capital City Young Republicans Club, trustee of the Kenyon Festival Theatre, and commissioner of the Ohio Elections Commission.

Along with his wife, Lou Ann, Mr. Moritz was an active advocate on behalf of the university throughout his life, serving as a director of The Ohio State University Foundation and the campaign committee of the Fisher College of Business, where he established the Moritz Family M.B.A. Scholarship Fund.

His unprecedented gift to the College of Law created a scholarship fund, which offers full tuition and a stipend for 30 Ohio State law students. It also finances leadership awards to three students each year and established four endowed faculty chairs. The gift also established the Gregory H. Williams Dean's Fund for Excellence, named for the college's former dean.

It is with deep respect and gratitude that Ohio State posthumously honors this generous and devoted friend and alumnus.

## Lou Ann Moritz Ransom

Distinguished Service Award

ou Ann Moritz Ransom is an active community volunteer and a long-time advocate for The Ohio State University.

After earning her certificate in dental hygiene at Ohio State in 1958, she married Michael E. Moritz, then a student in the College of Law. Their partnership was to last 43 years until Mr. Moritz's untimely death in 2002. In 2001, the couple made an unprecedented gift to the university's College of Law, which has enabled the college to provide student scholarships, make strategic new faculty hires, and support innovative programming. Their generosity was recognized with the naming of the college as

the Michael E. Moritz College of Law.

The couple's gifts to their university also include the creation of the Moritz Family M.B.A. Scholarship in the Fisher College of Business and support for the Wexner Center for the Arts, the Department of Athletics, and WOSU stations. In addition, Mrs. Ransom recently established the Michael Moritz Scholarship for members of the Phi Gamma Delta fraternity.

Mrs. Ransom continues to serve Ohio State as a director of The Ohio State University Foundation Board and as a member of the Moritz College of Law's National Council. She retains an ongoing commitment to the college through her involvement with the Moritz Law Scholars. Each year, the Moritz Law Scholarship Committee selects up to 10 members of the incoming class of law students to receive the prestigious Michael E. Moritz Scholarship—the highest honor awarded to a new student. Mrs. Ransom is instrumental in helping select the Moritz Law Scholars as well as the men and women who serve as their mentors.

The Columbus community also benefits from her support and vision through her service on the boards of the Homeless Families Foundation and the Marburn Academy.





he colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings called for caps and floorlength capes with attached hoods, and the sobering influence of the church probably influenced the staid character of the caps and gowns.

As the control of the universities gradually passed from the church, some

aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. Old prints and engravings, however, reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and that of the present day.

In light of our nation's English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity in regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed to prepare a code for caps, gowns, and hoods that has since been adopted by all academic institutions.

Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the familiar mortarboard square—

a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it covers any dress that might indicate rank or social status. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctoral and master's degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the university.

### The Gown

Bachelor: The bachelor gown is black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master: The master gown is black, long or short sleeves, with an arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor: The Ohio State University Doctor of Philosophy gown is scarlet with gray velvet panels on the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Other doctor gowns are black with velvet panels and bars, the color of which is distinctive of the field of study.

#### Honors Emblem

The Ohio State University honors emblem is a scarlet and gray tasseled braid worn over the gown. Students eligible for this curricular honor are those graduating *summa cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, *cum laude*, with distinction, and with honors.

### The Hood

Bachelor: Three feet long with a two-inch-wide velvet edging.\*

Master: Three and one-half feet long with a three-inch-wide velvet edging.

**Doctor:** Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet edging and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree. The color of the velvet indicates the field of study.


## Cap and Tassel

## THE LONG WALK

In 1893, the master plan for The Ohio State University campus proposed a group of buildings around a central open space. The first reference to this area as "the Oval" was around 1910. A year later, a very elaborate, geometric pattern of walks within the Oval was added to the plan. This included a lengthy east-west walk—today anchored on the west end by the William Oxley Thompson Library and on the east end by Page Hall and the Wexner Center for the Arts. By 1919-20, and possibly earlier, this came to be known as the "Long Walk." In the early years, freshmen were forbidden to be on the Long Walk. The penalty—occasionally enforced by upperclass students—was to be thrown into Mirror Lake.

As one of Ohio State's most notable landmarks, the Oval is a key aspect of the university's identity, as well as a hub of its active daily life.

In June 2004, a major restoration project got underway to ensure the Oval's historic character while, at the same time, to address the contemporary needs of the campus. Walkway replacement, an irrigation system, new turf, and new lighting will all help preserve the Oval's integrity and make the area better able to withstand and accommodate a wide variety of student activities and special events. The construction project was completed in June 2005.
