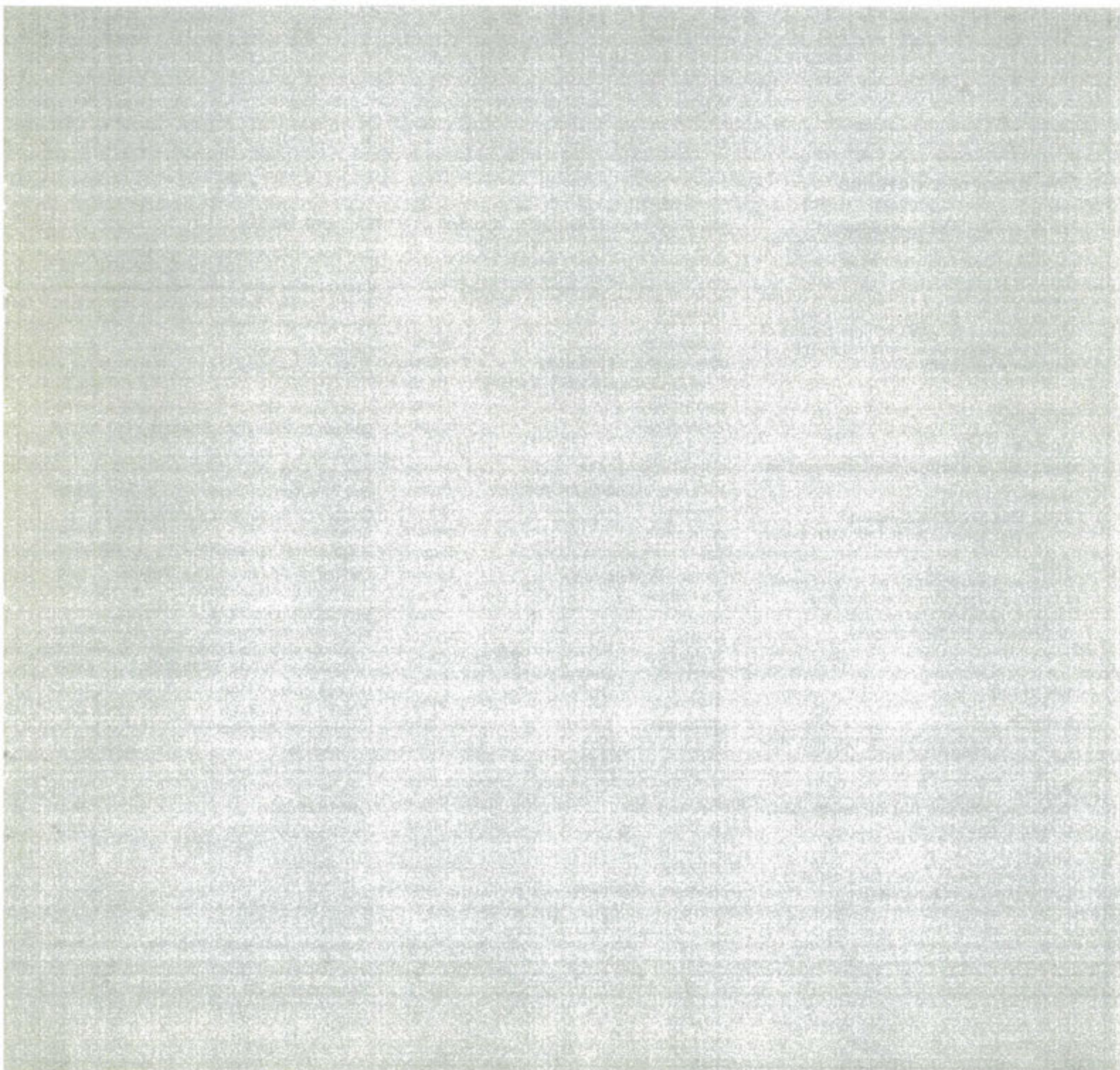

The Academic Costume

The American Council on Education, through the cooperation of its institutional members, has established the Academic Costume Code, which has been adopted almost completely by institutions of higher learning in this country. The following information is provided for the benefit of visitors to academic ceremonies at The Ohio State University.

THE GOWN

Bachelor

Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master

Black, long or short sleeves with arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor

Black, with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

THE HOOD

Bachelor

Three feet in length with a two-inch wide velvet.*

Master

Three and one-half feet in length with a three-inch wide velvet.*

Doctor

Four feet in length with a five-inch wide velvet and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution from which the degree was received. The color of the velvet on all hoods indicates the field of study as follows:

JOHN B. FULLEN

The Ohio State University
Distinguished Service Award

*Nationally recognized alumnus; loyal and respected
servant of The Ohio State University*

For nearly forty years, this dedicated alumnus served his fellow alumni and his university as an able and articulate leader in all aspects involving the Association and the Development Fund. Upon his retirement, he was saluted as one of the most resourceful and astute personalities in this field so meaningful to higher education.

John B. Fullen received a Bachelor of Science degree in journalism from this university in 1925, and his interest in communications was manifested throughout his career.

In the archives of his profession, the emergence of the two-way communication between the campus and the alumni owes much to his courage and eloquence.

In 1928, he was selected as alumni secretary at the University. As alumni secretary (title later changed to Director of Alumni Affairs), he served as editor of The Ohio State University *Monthly* and executive director of The Ohio State University Development Fund from its inception in 1939.

To each of these important assignments, he gave distinction and gained national recognition from the American Alumni Council.

From all whose lives have become intertwined with the purposes and traditions of this university, John B. Fullen commands high admiration and deep gratitude.

JAMES R. HULL, JR.

*An outstanding and productive force in alumni affairs;
respected and influential community servant*

The recipient of a degree in dentistry from this university in 1943, James R. Hull has given selfless service in behalf of his alma mater and his community. He has thereby won a unique and enduring place in the hearts of all those who love the University.

He brought a quality of leadership and boundless energy to Ohio State, where he was captain of the highly successful basketball team of 1939, which won the Big Ten Championship. That same intangible quality has underwritten his alumni service to his alma mater, as well as his role of dedicated citizenship.

In addition to service as an alumni representative to the Athletic Council, he served as a director of The Ohio State University Association. He served as reunion chairman for the Silver Anniversary of the Class of 1939. Through the years, he has made hundreds of speeches on behalf of the University, always stressing a sense of moral purpose and fundamental values of good citizenship.

Perhaps the best testimonial to his dedication and his ability is the one inscribed on a granite marker beneath a Buckeye tree in Ohio State's "All-American Arbor" near the Stadium:

THOMAS B. MEEK, SR.

Organizer, fund-raiser, friend of the University, and effective alumni leader

Thomas B. Meek, Sr., has made lasting contributions to The Ohio State University as a dedicated supporter of alumni affairs and as an able leader in fund-raising. His loyalty, hard work, and enlightened counsel have given notable service to the endeavors of this university.

Mr. Meek received the Bachelor of Science degree in journalism from this university in 1920. Over the years, despite the growing responsibilities of his business career, he has served his alma mater in a variety of ways.

His alumni activities have included the executive secretaryship of the Ohio Stadium committee, presidency of the New York Alumni Club, and campaign chairmanship of the Development Fund in New York. He has also served as the chairman of the national Development Fund Board of Directors, as well as the Journalism Committee of the Alumni Advisory Board.

As secretary of the Class of 1920, he is now working on the Centennial Reunion to be held in March, 1970. He continues to be a leading supporter of the James Thurber Collection in the University Libraries.

Thomas B. Meek, Sr., has been a devoted alumnus and an involved participant who has invested unselfishly of himself on behalf of this university.

DELBERT OBERTEUFFER
The Ohio State University
Distinguished Service Award

Devoted teacher, humanitarian, perceptive administrator in matters of University policy

Delbert Oberteuffer served with distinction from 1932 to 1966 as a member of the faculty of the Department of Physical Education. For twenty-four years as its chairman, education of the whole man was his theme. His personal drive was the generative force that elevated four education programs to the ranks of the best in the nation. These embraced curricula in freshman physical education and health education, teacher education for professional students in physical and health education, and graduate education in both fields.

As a University professor, he wore the academic robes with dignity and pride, stirred youth, stimulated scholars, prodded council members, encouraged the administration, and held high the central task of the University.

His achievements brought national fame to the University when three national organizations elected him president, four presented him their distinguished service award, and three universities gave him honorary degrees.

Delbert Oberteuffer has been a devoted leader, a respected counselor, a productive participant in University affairs, an author, and an educator who gave unselfishly of himself in order that the University might fulfill its most important mission.

DOROTHY D. SCOTT

The Ohio State University
Distinguished Service Award

*Revered teacher, administrator, nationally known and
valued leader in home economics*

Dorothy D. Scott served the School of Home Economics at The Ohio State University thirty-one years, the last thirteen as Director of the School and the last ten also as Associate Dean of the College of Agriculture and Home Economics. Under her administration, the School grew and progressed. She inspired colleagues and students by her professional standards of excellence, her spirit of service, and her concern for people.

Dr. Scott received the B.S. and M.S. from Ohio State, and the M.A. and Ed.D. from Columbia. In her early years as a faculty member, she played an important part in developing the student guidance program for the School of Home Economics. She served also as professor and chairman of home economics education and made significant contributions to teacher education and research.

Through her nation-wide leadership in academic circles and professional organizations, Dr. Scott brought honor to herself and to her alma mater. She served the University effectively in many roles, including membership on the Advisory Committee on the Selection of the President, Faculty Advisory Committee to the President and Board of Trustees, and the University Honorary Degrees Committee. In every dimension, the career of Dorothy D. Scott has been one of dedication and distinction.
