

## The Recipient of Honors

### **Tom Moody Doctor of Laws**

To the demanding tasks of public life, Tom Moody has brought fairness, courage, leadership, and a dedication to the people of Columbus he now serves as mayor. As a lawyer, city council member, judge, and chief executive of a major city, he has responded to the call of public service and has built a distinguished career. In a relatively short span of years, he has become a respected leader in his field, as evidenced by his election in 1977 as president of the National League of Cities, president of the International Union of Local Authorities, and as member of the Advisory Board of the United States Conference of Mayors. He has earned the title, "public servant," in all its full and finest meaning.

### **Recipients of the Distinguished Service Award**

#### **Harold J. Grimm**

As one of America's leading historians, Harold J. Grimm has enriched this University for more than three decades as professor, research scholar, and academic administrator. He has made a lasting contribution to the development of historical scholarship at this University.

He earned the personal esteem and professional recognition of his colleagues for a career of high distinction. The numerous honors and awards he has received attest to the breadth and quality of his accomplishments in his field and of his exemplary service to the University and community.

Beyond Dr. Grimm's contributions as scholar and as the distinguished chairman of the Department of History, his commitment to his students as teacher and mentor reflects the high vision of education which he holds. His dedication to those he teaches is reflected in the publication of a world-renowned textbook, as well as in the notable monographs he has written.

#### **James R. McCoy**

For nearly 45 years James R. McCoy devoted his personal and professional life to this University, interrupting his efforts only for wartime service. With high distinction, he served in positions of increasing responsibility, culminating in his distinguished leadership as dean of the College of Administrative Science.

To every assignment and role he accepted in behalf of this University, his alma mater, he brought a loyalty, a dedication, and a continuing desire to work toward the goal of educational excellence. Particularly notable were the contributions he

made through his service on the Athletic Council, the Council on Academic Affairs, and the University Senate.

Dean McCoy's deep involvement in his community, his profession, and this University and his commitment to their improvement have earned the respect and admiration of the many whose lives he has enriched.

#### **Edwin L. Mitchell**

The crucial role Edwin L. Mitchell played in the establishment and successful development of the Marion Campus has demonstrated the full measure of his dedication to the advancement of education and the service of this University.

As chairman of the Marion Area College Foundation, he helped raise the funds necessary to establish and build what has become a vital academic arm of Ohio State. An articulate and effective spokesman, he led the Marion Campus Citizens Council with authority and great skill.

Mr. Mitchell's deep concern for this University and for education is further reflected in his distinguished service as member and chairman of the Alumni Advisory Board and as a member of the National Council for the College of Law. The numerous tributes and honors he has received reveal the breadth of his many contributions and the high regard in which he is held by his fellow citizens.

#### **Edward F. Wagner**

As member and former chairman of the Development Fund Board of this University, Edward F. Wagner served with great distinction. Under his dynamic and innovative leadership, the University's fund-raising activities were reorganized and their results were increased dramatically, leading to three years of record-breaking success.

He also played an essential role in the initial development of a program to enhance the ties between the University and the central Ohio community. His memberships in The Presidents Club and the Alumni Association further reflect his continuing commitment to The Ohio State University.

For his generous investment of time and his personal efforts in support of higher education, Mr. Wagner has earned the continuing respect of his many friends and associates on the campus and in the community. His extensive background and influence in business and civic affairs have been of invaluable assistance to this University in pursuit of its goal of excellence.

## The Academic Costume

The colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University Commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics as well, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings made caps and floor-length capes with attached hoods a necessity for warmth. Probably because of the costumes' religious heritage, they remained drab until the universities gradually began to pass from the control of the Church, whereupon some aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. However, old prints and engravings reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and the academic costume worn today.

In light of our nation's strong English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity with regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed which prepared a code for caps, gowns, and hoods which has been adopted by all institutions. Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the more familiar mortarboard square — a shape which ballad folklore suggests resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship for it covers any dress which might indicate rank or social strata. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctor's degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the University.

## The Gown

**Bachelor** Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.  
**Master** Black, long or short sleeves with arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.  
**Doctor** Black, with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

## The Hood

**Bachelor** Three feet in length with a two-inch-wide velvet.\*  
**Master** Three and one-half feet in length with a three-inch-wide velvet.\*  
**Doctor** Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution from which the degree was received. The color of the velvet indicates the field in which the doctoral was granted:

## **University Hall**

Amid hammering and shouting, 24 students assembled in an incomplete University Hall and watched their professor improvise a lecture table with a carpenter's bench and conduct a physics demonstration with a dinner pail. It was the first day of classes at Ohio State University, known then as the Ohio Agricultural and Mechanical College.

That was back in 1873. During the more than 100 years that followed, Ohio State remained true to and expanded upon its original objectives: "to furnish a good general education by which the youth of Ohio shall be fitted for the several pursuits and professions of life . . . to produce opportunities for those who wish to pursue special studies."

To those ends, the University offers 250 academic programs to more than 55,000 students on six campuses. Ohio State is the headquarters for two unique research groups: the Institute of Polar Studies, the only multidisciplinary bi-polar institute in the nation, and the Disaster Research Center, the only such center in the world performing sociological research on reactions of groups and organizations in community-wide emergencies, particularly natural disasters.

Surrounded by the vigorous expansion of the last decade, a replica of University Hall stands on the original site. A testimony to past dedication and present commitment, University Hall once again honors Ohio State's pledge of quality education and public service.
