

## The Main Library

The Main Library of The Ohio State University opened its doors in 1913 to serve the needs of an enrollment of less than 4,000 students. Even then, its meager book collection had outgrown space originally provided in old University Hall and later in Orton Hall.

Situated at the west end of the Oval, the library is constructed in the Classical Renaissance style. Carved in relief above the three arched doorways at the main entrance are the great seals of the University, the state of Ohio, the Northwest Territory, and the United States. In the entrance plaza overlooking the Oval stands the imposing bronze figure of William Oxley Thompson, fifth president of the University, for whom the library was renamed in 1948. Major additions in 1951 and 1977 greatly expanded the library's seating area and book space and provided modern security and fire protection systems and improved access for the handicapped.

Today the University's library system is the largest academic and research collection in Ohio and the 15th largest in the United States. The system includes the Main Library and 36 specialized departmental libraries, ranging from agriculture to women's studies and veterinary medicine. The library system houses more than 3.5 million volumes and regularly receives more than 26,000 current periodicals. Unique collections range from Thurber, Cervantes, and American fiction to the Sears catalog and Star Trek scripts. In 1979 the library system welcomed more than 6 million patrons.

OSU is recognized internationally as a leader in the application of advanced computer technology to library services. The entire library system is connected by a computer control network which allows patrons rapid access to information. Rather than dehumanizing the library, modern technology enhances its highly individualized service to the Ohio State University community.

## **Recipients of Honors**

### **Marshall D. Shulman Doctor of Laws**

Distinguished scholar, teacher, and authority on foreign policy, Marshall D. Shulman is internationally recognized as an expert on Soviet-American relations. His scholarly research and writing reflect the keen insight into world affairs that has made him an invaluable adviser to government. His leadership in the academy, as director of the Russian Institute at Columbia University and in other key positions, has advanced the cause of world understanding. As Special Adviser to the Secretary of State on Soviet Affairs, Ambassador Shulman brings to public service the highest attributes of the scholarly tradition. The Ohio State University is pleased to honor him for his eminent career.

### **Barbee William Durham Distinguished Service Award**

As staff pharmacist and supervisor of the Reagent Laboratory, Barbee William Durham has served this University for more than 43 years with a high sense of professional mission and unusual dedication. Never one to be satisfied with merely getting the job done, he repeatedly found ways to do the job better. He was an invaluable partner of faculty. His skill and promptness in preparing compounds and his counsel to those engaged in research advanced the purposes of this University. His contributions to professional journals shared his insights with the wider academic community. Beyond the borders of the campus he demonstrated a deep concern for and made lasting contributions to the furtherance of interracial justice. In his personal and professional life, he has brought great credit to his alma mater.

### **Lawrence E. Kunkle Distinguished Service Award**

Professor emeritus of animal science, Lawrence E. Kunkle served this University with dedication and distinction for 40 years. Under his leadership, Ohio State developed a superior and unique Meat Laboratory program, combining research and teaching with the preparation and supply of meat for campus use. His research into the improvement of beef cattle and swine earned national distinction. His deep interest in students extended far beyond the requirements of the classroom. As coach of the meats judging team for 18 years, he gave Ohio State students invaluable counsel drawn from a lifetime of experience. His wide-ranging contributions to animal science and his many services in behalf of the total University provide a lasting example of academic citizenship in its fullest and finest meaning.

### **James W. Phillips Distinguished Service Award**

Loyal alumnus and abiding friend of this University, James W. Phillips has played a significant role in helping Ohio State meet the challenges of academic excellence. In generous measure he invested his time and talent to advance the cause of teaching and research. As chairman of the Development Fund Board of Directors, he provides essential leadership in furthering the University's program of private support. As treasurer of the OSU Alumni Association he demonstrated the deep commitment that has characterized his many services in behalf of alma mater. In all respects, he has been to this University a true friend and partner, sharing its visions and dedicated to its future. For his many contributions, he has earned the high regard and enduring gratitude of The Ohio State University.

**Jacqueline D. Sisson  
Distinguished Service Award**

Nationally recognized fine arts librarian, Jacqueline D. Sisson has served this University with unusual devotion. Her tenure as head of the Fine Arts Library has been marked by qualitative excellence, continuous growth, and involvement in all areas of library service, research, and publication. Under her skilled guidance, one of the finest art libraries in the state was developed at this University. Her pioneering work in regional library cooperation has become a national model. Her prominent position in national art associations has earned for her deserved recognition as a leading librarian in her field. An alumna of this University, she has brought great credit to her alma mater. Even more importantly, she has provided all who have been privileged to be her colleagues with an inspiring example of professional excellence.

**Grady Smith  
Distinguished Service Award**

Former Administration Building custodian, Grady Smith served this University for many years with great dignity and efficiency. His gracious smile, his personal charm, his humane attitude, and his total loyalty to this institution all joined to make him a symbol of the countless members of the supporting staff who dedicate their lives to this University and without whom it could not function. His friendly approach endeared him to all who worked with him. His personal standards of performance were of the highest order. **Leo G. Staley  
Distinguished Service Award**

Professor and director of intramural sports emeritus, Leo G. Staley served this University for 40 years with vision and vitality and played a key role in enriching the lives of thousands of students. Under his leadership for 27 years, the intramural program flourished. He added new sports, increased the number of teams, and promoted the program through an annual handbook—all with the objective of encouraging more students to share the values and benefits of intramural competition. **I. Keith Tyler  
Distinguished Service Award**


Professor emeritus in the College of Education, I. Keith Tyler has been an international leader for more than four decades in the use of radio and television for educational purposes. For 27 years he was the guiding force behind the Institute for Education by Radio and Television. In 1936, he established the highly prized Ohio State Awards to recognize and foster excellence in broadcasting. A gifted and dedicated teacher, he took particular interest in helping foreign students develop programs that could be transferred to other cultures. Through them his influence continues worldwide. The honors he has received can suggest only in a limited way the significance of his many contributions, the high regard and affection of his colleagues, and the unusual distinction with which he has served this University.

### **Francis P. Weisenburger Distinguished Service Award**

Professor emeritus of history, Francis P. Weisenburger served this University for nearly 50 years with a dedication surpassed only by his unfailing consideration of students and colleagues alike. His scholarly writing provides a rich heritage for students of Ohio history. His exceptional ability to inspire students was widely recognized. Not least among his many lasting contributions to this University is his book, *The Fawcett Years, 1956 to 1972*. The research and writing that went into this volume of the University's history were a labor of love, reflecting a continuing devotion to his scholarly discipline and to the University he served so well for so long. He has earned the abiding affection and respect of his students and colleagues, the ultimate tribute to one who pursues the academic life.



# The Academic Costume

The colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University Commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics as well, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings made caps and floor-length capes with attached hoods a necessity for warmth. Probably because of the costumes' religious heritage, they remained drab until the universities gradually began to pass from the control of the Church, whereupon some aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. However, old prints and engravings reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and the academic costume worn today.

In light of our nation's strong English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity with regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed which prepared a code for caps, gowns, and hoods which has been adopted by all institutions. Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the more familiar mortarboard square — a shape which ballad folklore suggests resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship for it covers any dress which might indicate rank or social strata. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctor's degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the University.

## The Gown

**Bachelor** Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

**Master** Black, long or short sleeves with arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

**Doctor** Black, with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

## The Hood

**Bachelor** Three feet in length with a two-inch-wide velvet.\*

**Master** Three and one-half feet in length with a three-inch-wide velvet.\*

**Doctor** Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution from which the degree was received. The color of the velvet indicates the field in which the doctoral was granted:
