

## Commencement Address

#### Barbara A. Reynolds Doctor of Humane Letters

Barbara A. Reynolds, a columnist for *USA Today* for eight years and start-up editor of its opinion-editorial page, is president of Reynolds News Service.

Born in Columbus, Ms. Reynolds graduated from Ohio State in 1967 with a Bachelor of Arts in journalism. She worked briefly for the Columbus Call & Post before becoming a police beat reporter for the now-defunct Cleveland Press in 1968. She became an assistant editor at Ebony magazine later that same year. She joined the staff of the Chicago Tribune Co. in 1969, becoming an urban affairs reporter for the Tribune in 1972 and, in 1979, the paper's Washington correspondent.

While at the *Tribune*, Ms. Reynolds began airing regular radio commentaries for WBBM-Radio and free-lance writing for such magazines as *Essence*, *Playboy*, *The New Republic*, and *Black Family*. She was cofounder of *Dollars and Sense*, a magazine for African American professionals, and served as the magazine's international editor.

She founded Reynolds News Service in 1981, supplying columns and commentaries to news organizations including National Public Radio, Pacific News Service, and various national newspapers. In 1983, she joined the editorial board of *USA Today*, becoming its Inquiry Page editor in 1983 and a columnist in 1988. Through her weekly column, "From the Heart," she offered millions of readers her opinions—no matter how controversial—on racism, religion, and politics. Ms. Reynolds left the paper in 1996 to pursue new professional opportunities.

Ms. Reynolds is the author of And Still We Rise, 50 Black Role Models, and The Man, the Movement, and the Myth, which was updated in 1985 under the title Jesse Jackson: America's David. She studied constitutional law at Harvard University in 1976 as a Nieman Foundation Fellow. A 1991 graduate of the Howard University School of Divinity, she is an ordained minister and is currently working on her doctorate at the United Theological Seminary in Dayton, Ohio.

Among her many honors are the Drum Major for Justice Award from the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, the President's Award from the National Association of Negro Business and Professional Women, Ohio State's Office of Minority Affairs Distinguished Alumna Award, and the University of Missouri's Distinguished Service Award in Journalism. She holds an honorary degree from Shenandoah University and is a member of the Columbus Public Schools' Hall of Fame.

It is with great pride that Ohio State adds its own honor to those already held by this distinguished journalist and alumna and welcomes her as our commencement speaker.

# Recipients of Honors

George H. Alber Doctor of Business Administration

Entrepreneur, community leader, and philanthropist, George H. Alber received his business administration degree from Ohio State in 1929. He is the founder of Marion Plant Life Services, which, when he sold it in 1971, was the largest privately owned fertilizer company in the United States.

During his years at Ohio State, the Toledo native was a member of Phi Delta Theta fraternity and Sphinx honorary, president of his junior class, and a three-year letterman in football.

Following graduation and a period of employment with Goodrich Silvertown in Detroit, Mr. Alber returned to Central Ohio and, after discussions with local farmers and business people in the Marion area and consultation with experts at Ohio State, began his fertilizer business in 1937. Plant Life eventually expanded to five subsidiaries in Ohio.

Long committed to the accessibility of a quality education, Mr. Alber has been vitally interested in Ohio State's regional campus in Marion since its inception 30 years ago. He established the Dorothy and George H. Alber Endowed Scholarship Fund to aid students at the Marion campus, and has provided for the construction of the campus Alber Bell Tower. He is a member of the Ohio State-Marion Volunteer Committee for the university's current fund-raising campaign.

In recognition of his generosity and interest in both the university and the surrounding community, the first campus-based economic development resource center in Ohio has been named the George H. Alber Enterprise Center. A joint venture of the state of Ohio and Ohio State University Extension, the center will be a catalyst for economic development in Ohio's sevencounty North Central region.

Since his retirement, Mr. Alber has become involved in horse racing and breeding. He has continued his active participation in community and civic projects, including the United Way of Marion County, the Red Cross, Harding Area Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts, the Marion Salvation Army, and the Marion YMCA. He is a member of the Marion Rotary Club and is a former director of National City Bank.

Ohio State gratefully recognizes the commitment to the importance of education and the ideals of hard work embodied in this distinguished alumnus.

Robert F. Furchgott Doctor of Science

A pioneering research scientist and academician, Robert F. Furchgott has made notable contributions to the fields of biology, physiology, and pharmacology.

Presently distinguished professor at the State University of New York Health Science Center at Brooklyn and adjunct professor in the University of Miami School of Medicine's Department of Pharmacology, Dr. Furchgott served as chair of SUNY Downstate Medical Center Department of Pharmacology from 1956 to 1982.

Born in Charleston, South Carolina, Dr. Furchgott received a Bachelor of Science in chemistry from the University of North Carolina in 1937 and a doctorate in biochemistry from Northwestern University in 1940. He was on the medical faculty of Cornell University Medical College from 1943-49 before joining the pharmacology department at Washington University School of Medicine, where he remained until 1956.

Dr. Furchgott is internationally known for his research in cardiovascular pharmacology, adrenergic mechanisms, theory of drug-receptor mechanisms, and vascular pharmacology and physiology. His ground-breaking work on vascular relaxation and drug receptor theory has been vital in the development of new drugs to prevent sudden coronary-related death.

An active academician for 50 years, Dr. Furchgott has authored or coauthored some 200 articles in a scientific journals and has served on the editorial boards of 10 such journals. His service to the scientific community includes membership in the American Society for Pharmacology and Experimental Therapeutics, where he served as chair of several important committees and as president. He is a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science and the New York Academy of Sciences and was elected to the National Academy of Sciences in 1990.

Among his many awards are the CIBA Award from the Hypertension Section of the American Heart Association, the Research Achievement Award of the American Heart Association, the first Annual Bristol-Myers Squibb Award for Achievement in Cardiovascular Research, the Gairdner Foundation International Award, and the Medal of the New York Academy of Medicine.

Ohio State is proud to add its own recognition of this distinguished researcher and scholar.

# Recipients of Honors

Richard J. Denman Distinguished Service Award

Richard J. Denman is the retired president of Symedix, a Johnson & Johnson subsidiary formed in 1982 to collaborate with Philadelphia's Thomas Jefferson University on a new method for treatment of stroke.

A 1957 graduate of Ohio State in business administration, Mr. Denman also holds a Bachelor of Arts from the University of Toledo and a Master of Business Administration from Long Beach State University.

He held a variety of management and sales positions with Cordis Dow Corporation, Baxter International Inc., and Hyland Laboratories before founding Kyle-Richard Medical Inc. in 1975, an artificial kidney supply distributor and provider of patient services. He served as president of the California-based company until 1982 when he sold it to Johnson & Johnson Cardiovascular, where he assumed the position of vice president for business development

From 1982 to 1983, he also served as vice president of Erika Inc., a manufacturer and distributor of dialysis products. Mr. Denman retired from Symedix in 1985.

Mr. Denman, who developed a medical device for an artificial kidney machine, is a member of the National Kidney Foundation and the American Society for Artificial Internal Organs.

A loyal supporter of the university since his graduation, Mr. Denman and his wife have established the Richard J. and Martha D. Denman Professorship for Clinical Research in Epilepsy, which will attract to the university an eminent scholar in neurological research.

With more than 30 years in health care, he is volunteering his time and expertise to help strengthen the university through his service on the Ohio State Campaign's Health Sciences Development Council and California Major Gifts Committee. During Ohio State's first major campaign from 1985-90, Mr. Denman served as a charter member of the National Campaign Committee and the Ohio State University Foundation Board.

He is a member of the Presidents Club, a life member in the College of Medicine's Order of Hippocrates, and a life member in the Ohio State Alumni Association.

Ohio State proudly recognizes the unfailing support and many contributions of this dedicated alumnus.

Simon Dinitz Distinguished Service Award

Simon Dinitz, emeritus professor of sociology, served on the Ohio State faculty from 1951 until 1991, gaining an international reputation for distinguished scholarship in criminology, corrections, and mental health.

Dr. Dinitz attended the College of the City of New York for one year before joining the U.S. Navy during World War II. He earned his Bachelor of Arts at Vanderbilt University in 1947 and a master's degree and doctorate in sociology from the University of Wisconsin in 1949 and 1951 respectively.

He joined the Ohio State sociology faculty as an instructor, rising through the academic ranks to full professor in 1963. He also held the posts of senior fellow in the university's Academy for Contemporary Problems from 1975 to 1982 and research associate in psychiatry from 1957 to 1974. He continues to be sought after as a visiting professor at universities both in this country and abroad.

During his 40-year tenure at Ohio State, he taught thousands of undergraduate students and guided numerous graduate students toward their degrees. He was the first faculty member to receive both the Ohio State Alumni Award for Distinguished Teaching and the Distinguished Scholar Award. In 1969, the *Chicago Tribune* featured him as one of the Big Ten's 10 most exciting teachers. The Council for the Advancement and Support of Education chose him as one of six Teachers of the Year in 1981 and as one of the 25 outstanding U.S. professors the following year.


Dr. Dinitz is author or coauthor of 16 books, numerous monographs, and more than 120 professional journal articles and chapters.

He has served Ohio State in numerous capacities, including chairing the 300th Commencement Committee, the Task Force on the Fisher Guide Research Program, and the Ad Hoc Committee on the Department of Youth Services/Ohio State Research and Treatment Center. In 1981, he became the first faculty member since World War II to address an Ohio State commencement.

His many accomplishments have been recognized with such honors as the Sutherland Award of the American Society of Criminology, the Smith Award of the Academy of Criminal Justice Sciences, and the Hofheimer Prize for Research of the American Society of Criminology.

Ohio State is proud to add its own recognition of the impressive achievements and service of this eminent teacher, scholar, and faculty member.

# A Message From President Gee



ost of us measure our lives in year-long cycles, beginning in January and ending in December. But those of us in education observe a different calendar—one in which the year-end celebration is a graduation, and the days are counted in quarters or semesters.

For college students, the cycle begins that first autumn when they arrive on campus and advances through classes and exams, vacations and summer jobs, until commencement day finally arrives. And that day comes once each quarter when students from Ohio State graduate to the cheers of proud relatives and friends.

Now, these newly minted alumni will look back briefly and move on, shifting into the day-to-day rhythms of hoped-for employment. They will leave behind late nights filled with cold pizza and hot debate. No more 7:30 in the morning classes, but instead a 7:30 commute to the office. No more papers due for class, but reports due for work. They will trade their backpacks for briefcases, their ball caps for business suits.

There is no doubt that they have been changed by their college experience. Those years spent at a major research university represent not only a growth in knowledge, but a growth in wisdom and common sense—a maturing process that prepares a student for life in the "real world." And that world does not stand still.

We need only look at the capitals of the world and the corporations of America to realize that powerful forces have been at work. During the time it has taken this most recent crop of graduates to complete their educations, the Soviet Union has come apart, Germany has come together, ethnic warfare has erupted, trade barriers have fallen, and once-mighty businesses have been brought to their knees by economic forces.

Today's graduates are being launched into a world made smaller by the media and larger by the scope of our global dilemmas: the environment, ethics, illiteracy, racism, sexism, revolution, protest, famine, and poverty.

The world is crying for the compassion and creativity of our graduates. And we need their considerable energy and ingenuity to resolve conflicts, regain civility, and restore our spirits.

That is why, for all of us, graduation is a time that renews our hope in the future. As I preside over Ohio State's commencement, I am impressed by the intelligence, dedication, and vigor of our new college graduates, young and not so young. And I feel an old, familiar feeling: optimism. Optimism about the actions our industries are taking to regain a competitive edge. Optimism about the adjustments education is making in response to a changing society. And, most of all, optimism about and faith in this new generation that is about to take its place in our society.

Today, as many of them leave school behind, their memories are bittersweet. One of Ohio State's engineering graduates sent me a letter that, I believe, captures the great joy we share in this special rite of passage and the strength of the educational process. She wrote, "There will be at least one chemical engineer with a tear in her eye as the national anthem is played, a lump in her throat as her college is introduced, a smile on her face as she gets her diploma, and a cry of joy as her father hugs her and says, 'I am so proud of you!'"

It is a pride in which we can all share. I thank this graduate, and thousands like her, for all they will bring to our society. They are very bright. They work very hard. They have learned to live without security, but they continue to seek it. They are ready not only to cope with change, but to create change. And they have turned away from "me-ism" and are again seeking ways to help their fellow human beings.

I am confident that when this generation assumes leadership, America will be in very good hands.



### The Academic Costume

The colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University Commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings called for caps and floorlength capes with attached hoods, and the sobering influence of the church probably influenced the staid character of the caps and gowns.

As the control of the universities gradually passed from the church, some aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. Old prints and engravings, however, reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and that of the present day.

In the light of our nation's English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity in regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed to prepare a code for caps, gowns, and hoods that has since been adopted by all academic institutions.

Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the familiar mortarboard square—a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it covers any dress that might indicate rank or social status. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctoral degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the university.

### The Gown

Bachelor. Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves. Master. Black, long or short sleeves with a re-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor. Black with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

### The Hood

Bachelor. Three feet long with a two-inch-wide velvet edging.\*

Master. Three and one-half feet long with a three-inchwide velvet edging.\*

Doctor. Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet edging and panel at the sides.

\* Not usually worn by candidates for a degree. The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree. The color of the velvet indicates the field of study:
