Pomp, Circumstance, and Other Songs of a Lifetime

 —by David Citino, Professor of English and Creative Writing and University Poet Laureate (Originally presented as the 2000 Winter Commencement address)

If you're like me, you've got a big head, not to mention a funny robe, full of music poems and melodies, the tunes we move to, shower and shave by, study, write to. Not just the incidental,

but the momentous music keeping time. Our histories are measures of song. Listen to your heart: drums of Africa, sea-spume of blind, far-sighted Homer, Sappho's honeyed love lyrics. Often,

music speaks for us, one note saying a thousand words. Like Rodolpho in Puccini's La Boheme, Sono un poeta, I am a poet. Che cosa faccio? What do I do? Scrivo. I write. This ceremony

is loud music—pomp and circumstance of the life you began freshman year or that first day of graduate school. In my head I press *Play*, and the CD of Big Days kicks on. I leap and linger

over moments too sweet, nearly, for words. I'll never escape rhymes from the nursery. Up above the world so high, like a diamond in the sky. We knew from the start our universe was aglow with wonder.

Italian, Latin, English songs in nasal accents of Cleveland. Gaudeanns igitur, Juvenes dum sumus. So, let us rejoice, while we are young. Youth is that gift we can't comprehend while we're young. This ceremony

means you all are less young than you were. Don't let the heavy knowledge gained from your studies deprive you of the gifts of youth, to be able to rejoice at the drop of a hat, to care for, be moved by others.

Now I hear golden hits of five decades. Big Mama Thornton, and that so-called King (King of what, fried butter sandwiches?) who stole away her hound dog. You ain't never killed a rabbit, you ain't no friend

of mine. As with those profs and TAs, course after course, you had to produce kill some rabbits—to earn respect. And at times OSU may have seemed like Heartbreak Hotel, down at the end

of Lonely Street, so difficult was it to do your best. Tennessee Ernie Ford, "Sixteen Tons": St. Peter don't you call me 'Cause I can't go. I owe my soul to the company store. You have been digging deep in mines of knowledge. We all owe our souls to Ohio State, company store of learning, shared experience—precious ore we have in common forever.

Now I hear Domenico Modugno's fervent urging to wish, sing, fly, Volare, Wo-oo. Cantare, Wo-o-o-o. My grandfather was a peasant farmer, a contadino in Calabria in the toe

of Italy. He knew it's the human lot to dream of flying. Lucky, lucky, lucky me, I'm a lucky son-of-a-gun. I work eight hours, I sleep eight hours, That leaves eight hours for fun.

Hey! He sailed in steerage across the Atlantic, came to Cleveland, where he stayed long enough to work 52 years for the B&O Railroad, before lying down to rest in good Ohio soil. So many of us

here today came from elsewhere, or ancestors did. From Tennessee, Italy, Africa, Asia, Appalachia—even, President Kirwan, the wilds of Kentucky and Maryland. Women and men with backs

supple as birch trunks. The courage it took to pick up stakes and begin again in a new world! Think of the work those older ones did. For you. You all are facing a change right now.

This sheepskin is your passport. You're bound for emigration to the next song of your life. Ohio State is the ark on which you've been sailing. You've been the precious cargo.

But, as Noah once said, I can see clearly now the rain is gone. The ark, our university, was filled to overflowing with the diversity of us. Diversity. Networks and talk shows devalue the word.

I say, rather, the richness of us, precious difference, the grand multiplicity of selves that balance this globe and enable it to spin true. Grandson of peasant immigrants, I was given

the opportunity to earn a doctorate in English literature from Ohio State because my family labored long nights around the kitchen table trying to learn this arduous English. I sat where you're sitting twenty-six years ago.
Bob Dylan and Smokey Robinson got me
through. Yes, it took a prophet and Miracles!
My son earned an OSU Ph.D. in history.
Now you, graduates, are being honored—

by degrees. We've all come together around the kitchen table of Ohio State. Ohio, Round on the ends and high in the middle. For the years to come we'll sing together, Beautiful Ohio,

in dreams again I see, Visions of what used to be. These psalms, sacred thoughts of our tribes, 78's and 33's, tapes, CD's—they take up space in shelves of our skulls, our hearts. They remind us

we want a song beyond the runof-the-mill thrill, the moment throbbing with pleasure or bathed in the blues. We ache for something grander than pure selfishness. Songs sung for one

alone are not true music. Arias shared are music of the spheres, ways of saying to another something from the soul. Of course the Buckeye Battle Cry is there. Drive, drive on down the field,

Men (and women!) of the Scarlet and Gray. Well, you drove on down the field, and you drove up and down the streets, around and around crowded lots, looking for a place to park,

and you searched our dark, ancient library for a decent place to study. My wife, Mary's, father marched in the first "Script Ohio," in 1936. He's here today with us, blowing his horn, I can't help

but feel, as is the sweet mother I lost last year, the one who gave me the stars. Today's music makes us think of the debts we owe, and never can repay. So many of us would not be here

were it not for the lullabyes and songs of dear parents, their parents, theirs. Some are here today in the flesh. Many are not. We mourn them with cadences, of our hearts. Think how many people

sang before us, gave us a name, a voice, taught us the right words. We must cherish them by remembering every song. When we sing to others, we honor our fathers and mothers, thank them

for this day of profound scarlet and gray pomp and circumstance. O, come let's sing Ohio's praise, And songs to Alma Mater raise. Alma mater. Ohio State is our sweet, nurturing mother

We came of age here, with her help. Well, Mother, we love you, but, like, it's time we moved out, got a place of our own. You're standing there, Mom, gray hair, eyes scarlet

from crying. We won't forget you. Now, even though this ceremony means we're being weaned, taken off the nipple, let's take care to cherish her all our days. Let's remember

the words to the songs she taught us, and pass them on. We'll remember always, Graduation Day. Summer's heat, and winter's cold, The seasons pass, the years will roll, Time and change

will surely show How firm thy friendship, O-hi-O. We call that little number Carmen Ohio. Carmen means song in Latin. You've worked hard; she is your reward; today is your reward.

You're filled to overflowing with the notes, the poems we've written together. You know the score. Continue to work hard for yourselves, and one another. Find the ones who need

you to sing to, for them, in the world. Graduates, this joyful litany, this hymn our ancestors collaborated on with us, the calling of your name today is music to our ears. Sing that name proudly

all your days, as if your life depended on it. It does, you know. It has been an honor for me to speak—and sing to you today. Thank you, graduates, and, again, Congratulations.



Lee S. Shulman

ee S. Shulman was named eighth president of The Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching in 1997. The foundation was created by Andrew Carnegie in 1905 and chartered by the United States Congress in 1906 "to do and perform all things necessary to encourage, uphold, and dignify the profession of teaching."

Dr. Shulman, who earned his bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees from the University of Chicago, is Charles E. Ducommun Professor of Education Emeritus at Stanford University. Prior to joining Stanford's education faculty, he was professor of educational psychology and medical education at Michigan State University from 1963 to 1982. While at Michigan State, he co-founded the Institute for Research on Teaching (IRT) in 1976.

Dr. Shulman's research and publications have dealt with the study of teaching and teacher education; the growth of knowledge among those learning to teach; the assessment of teaching; medical education; the psychology of instruction in science, mathematics, and medicine; the logic of educational research; and the quality of teaching in higher education.

His studies of medical reasoning with Arthur Elstein were considered the most thorough investigations of the cognitive processes of medical problem solving when published in 1978 by Harvard University Press. His research group at Stanford laid the conceptual foundations for a reconsideration of the nature of teacher knowledge, with special reference to the role of content understanding in the pedagogical process. Between 1985 and 1990, Dr. Shulman and his colleagues

conducted the technical studies and field tests that supported the creation of the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards.

Dr. Shulman is a past president of the American Educational Research Association, which awarded him its highest honor, the career award for Distinguished Contributions to Educational Research. He is a member of the National Academy of Education, where he served as both vice president and president. In 1995, he received the E.L. Thorndike Award for Distinguished Psychological Contributions to Education from the American Psychological Association's Division of Educational Psychology. He was elected a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences in 2002.

Ohio State proudly welcomes this distinguished educator to address its graduating class.

Ernest M. Henley

rnest M. Henley is professor emeritus in the Department of Physics at the University of Washington. He is widely respected as one of the most original and influential theoretical nuclear physicists in the scientific community today.

After earning his Ph.D. in physics from the University of California, Berkeley, in 1952, Dr. Henley was a lecturer at Columbia University before joining the faculty at the University of Washington in 1954 as an assistant professor of physics, becoming a full professor in 1961. During his tenure at the University of Washington, he has proven a skilled administrator, serving as chair of the University Faculty Senate, chair of the Department of Physics, and

dean of the College of Arts and Sciences. In 1990, he played a leading role in founding the university's Institute for Nuclear Theory, serving as director for its inaugural year and continuing to serve as its associate director.

His research interests have had a profound effect on the field of particle and nuclear physics. His main impact has been in the area of symmetry violations in nuclei, which have led to important tests of the standard model of particle physics and to the measurement of a unique property of atoms called anapole movement.

Dr. Henley is a member of the National Academy of Sciences, having served as chair of its Physics Section; and a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science, American Academy of Arts and Sciences, and the American Physical Society, where he served as president in 1992, as chair of the Nuclear Physics Division from 1979 to 1980, and serves as co-founder and secretary-treasurer of the society's Northwest Section. He has been a Distinguished Scholar to the People's Republic of China and has chaired the Nuclear Science Advisory Committee, which advises the federal government on all major funding issues in nuclear physics.

Dr. Henley is the author or coauthor of some 200 scholarly journal articles, more than 20 book chapters, and six books. He is currently at work on a third edition of Nuclear and Particle Physics, first published in 1975. He continues to do research on the early universe and neutrinos in astrophysics.

Howard M. Johnson Doctor of Science

oward M. Johnson is Graduate
Research Professor in the Department of Microbiology and Cell
Science at the University of Florida. He
has received international recognition for
his contributions to understanding the
role of interferons and superantigens as
modulators of the immune response. The
research has played an important role in
the use of interferon in the treatment of

multiple sclerosis.

A native of Maryland, Dr. Johnson's elementary education began modestly in a two-room building with no running water or central heating. However, his strong commitment to education ultimately led him to The Ohio State University where he received his bachelor's, master's, and Ph.D. degrees and began his research in immunology. After receiving his doctorate, he worked with the Food and Drug Administration in

Cincinnati from 1963 to 1975 before receiving an academic appointment as associate professor in the University of Texas Medical Branch's Department of Microbiology in Galveston. He rose to the rank of full professor in 1978.

In 1984 he joined the University of Florida faculty as professor in the Department of Comparative and Experimental Pathology, and in 1988 he was named Graduate Research Professor, one of the university's highest academic distinctions. He also served as a University of Florida Research Foundation Professor from 1997 to 2000.

During his academic career, Dr. Johnson has been the recipient of numerous National Institutes of Health grants, has published more than 260 scholarly research papers, and has mentored 14 graduate students and nine postdoctoral researchers. He has served on the Graduate

Study Panel of the National Science Foundation and the editorial boards of the Journal of Immunology and Infection and Immunity. He was a member of the National Advisory Council of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases from 1994 to 1998 and the Research Committee of the American Heart Association from 1991 to 1996. In these positions, he was responsible for evaluating and approving research projects nationwide, involving annual expenditures of more than \$1 billion.

Dr. Johnson was instrumental in establishing a Center for Inflammatory Host Defense and Tissue Injury at the University of Florida, serving as its first director. And he is the founder and president of a start-up biotechnology company, Superferons Inc.

Clarence R. Cole Distinguished Service Award

larence R. Cole is Regents
Professor Emeritus in veterinary
pathobiology in The Ohio State
University College of Veterinary Medicine.
During his long tenure at Ohio State, he
was a leading proponent of veterinary
research for the benefit of both animals
and humans, bringing national attention
to his college and to his alma mater.

Dr. Cole earned his doctor of veterinary medicine degree in 1943, a master's degree in veterinary pathology in 1944, and a Ph.D. in pathobiology in 1947, all from Ohio State, before joining the university's faculty in 1947. After rising through the academic ranks to professor of veterinary pathology in the College of Veterinary Medicine and professor of comparative pathology in the College of Medicine and Public Health, he was named Regents

Professor by the Ohio Board of Regents in 1971. He retired from the university in 1985.

During his years as assistant dean for research development from 1960 to 1967 and then dean of the College of Veterinary Medicine from 1967 to 1971, Dr. Cole was responsible for a number of innovative changes. He planned and secured extramural funding from the National Institutes of Health and the State of Ohio for two major buildings —the Veterinary Teaching Hospital and Goss Laboratories. He designed and initiated the college's precedent-setting integrated body systems-oriented, core-elective curriculum, still in place today. He began admission procedures for students based on merit without regard to gender and expanded graduate education, and he

established interdisciplinary programs between the Colleges of Veterinary Medicine and Medicine. During this time, he obtained grants and gifts to the college totaling more than \$16.5 billion.

A stimulating teacher, Dr. Cole has published extensively, lectured throughout the world on pathobiology and veterinary education, and serves as an advisor to the World Health Organization. He is a founder of the American College of Veterinary Pathologists, serving as its president in 1957.

He received the College of Veterinary Medicine's Distinguished Alumnus Award in 1986, and his many contributions are acknowledged by a plaque on the Clarence R. Cole Deans' Suite in the new Veterinary Medicine Academic Building.

Elaine H. Hairston Distinguished Service Award

laine H. Hairston is chancellor emerita of the Ohio Board of Regents and senior consultant with the Academic Search Consultation Service in Washington, D.C., where she assists boards of trustees with university

presidential searches.

Dr. Hairston completed all her academic degrees at The Ohio State University, receiving a bachelor of arts in English in 1966, master's in speech in 1967, and Ph.D. in communication in 1970. In 1971, she was named the university's first associate director of affirmative action programs, playing a leading role in establishing the first childcare center on any Ohio public university campus and in gaining admission for women into graduate and professional schools and into the Ohio State Marching Band. In 1976, as assistant vice president for the offices of admissions and registration services for Ohio State's 55,000 undergraduate, graduate, and professional students, Dr. Hairston helped ease student enrollment processes.

In 1979, she was named vice chancellor for academic programs at the Ohio Board of Regents and was chief architect of the board's innovative Selective Excellence Program, which included the Ohio Eminent Scholars Program, a \$60 million state strategy designed to improve quality on Ohio campuses. As Ohio's youngest and first female chancellor of the Board of Regents (1990-97), Dr. Hairston led one of the nation's largest and most complex systems of higher education through a period of significant change, positioning it for a healthy future. She was responsible for the planning, budgeting, and coordination of Ohio's 65 public college and university campuses with a combined enrollment of 400,000 and an annual operating budget of more than \$2 billion. While chancellor, she encouraged research consortia, expanded Ohio's community college system, led the development of OhioLINK (a cuttingedge online statewide academic library system), facilitated the full transfer of academic course credits among the state's colleges and universities, supported the establishment of childcare centers on all campuses, and pressed campuses to cut costs and improve efficiency.

Since retiring as chancellor in 1998, Dr. Hairston has continued her service to Ohio State in a variety of capacities. She was a member of the Arthur G. James Cancer Hospital and Richard M. Solove Research Center Foundation Board and an Ohio State Distinguished Visiting Scholar. She served as chair of the Alumni Advisory Council of Ohio State's Alumni Association from 2001 to 2003, and currently serves on the Advisory Committee to the University Honors Program. Dr. Hairston is the recipient of the 1984 Professional Excellence Award of the Department of Communication. In 1987, she was honored at the university's 300th commencement for her achievements. She received the 1998 College of Humanities Alumni Award of Distinction and, in 1999, The Ohio State University Alumni Association Professional Achievement Award.







he colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings called for caps and floorlength capes with attached hoods, and the sobering influence of the church probably influenced the staid character of the caps and gowns.

As the control of the universities gradually passed from the church, some

aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. Old prints and engravings, however, reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and that of the present day.

In light of our nation's English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity in regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed to prepare a code for caps, gowns, and hoods that has since been adopted by all academic institutions.

Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the familiar mortarboard square—

a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it covers any dress that might indicate rank or social status. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctoral and master's degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the university.

The Gown

Bachelor: The bachelor gown is black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master: The master gown is black, long or short sleeves, with an arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor: The Ohio State University Doctor of Philosophy gown is scarlet with gray velvet panels on the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Other doctor gowns are black with velvet panels and bars, the color of which is distinctive of the field of study.

Honors Emblem

The Ohio State University honors emblem is a scarlet and gray tasseled braid worn over the gown. Students eligible for this curricular honor are those graduating *summa cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, *cum laude*, with distinction, and with honors.

The Hood

Bachelor: Three feet long with a two-inch-wide velvet edging.* Master: Three and one-half feet long with a three-inch-wide velvet edging.

Doctor: Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet edging and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree. The color of the velvet indicates the field of study:




