

POMP, CIRCUMSTANCE, AND OTHER SONGS OF A LIFETIME

(Originally presented as the 2000 Winter Commencement address)

If you're like me, you've got a big head, not to mention a funny robe, full of music—poems and melodies, the tunes we move to, shower and shave by, study, write to. Not just the incidental,

but the momentous music keeping time. Our histories are measures of song. Listen to your heart: drums of Africa, sea-spume of blind, far-sighted Homer, Sappho's honeyed love lyrics. Often,

music speaks for us, one note saying a thousand words. Like Rodolpho in Puccini's La Boheme, Sono un poeta. I am a poet. Che cosa faccio? What do I do? Scrivo. I write. This ceremony

is loud music—pomp and circumstance of the life you began freshman year or that first day of graduate school. In my head I press *Play*, and the CD of Big Days kicks on. I leap and linger

over moments too sweet, nearly, for words. I'll never escape rhymes from the nursery. Up above the world so high, like a diamond in the sky. We knew from the start our universe was aglow with wonder.

Italian, Latin, English songs in nasal accents of Cleveland. Gaudeanus igitur, Juvenes dum sumus. So, let us rejoice, while we are young. Youth is that gift we can't comprehend while we're young. This ceremony

means you all are less young than you were. Don't let the heavy knowledge gained from your studies deprive you of the gifts of youth, to be able to rejoice at the drop of a hat, to care for, be moved by others.

Now I hear golden hits of five decades. Big Mama Thornton, and that so-called King (King of what, fried butter sandwiches?) who stole away her hound dog. You ain't never killed a rabbit, you ain't no friend

of mine. As with those profs and TAs, course after course, you had to produce—kill some rabbits—to earn respect. And at times OSU may have seemed like Heartbreak Hotel, down at the end

of Lonely Street, so difficult was it to do your best. Tennessee Ernie Ford, "Sixteen Tons": St. Peter don't you call me 'Cause I can't go. I owe my soul to the company store. You have been digging deep in mines of knowledge. We all owe our souls to Ohio State, company store of learning, shared experience—precious ore we have in common forever.

Now I hear Domenico Modugno's fervent urging to wish, sing, fly, Volare, Wo-oo. Cantare, Wo-o-o-o. My grandfather was a peasant farmer, a contadino in Calabria in the toe

of Italy. He knew it's the human lot to dream of flying. Lucky, lucky, lucky me, I'm a lucky son-of-a-gun. I work eight hours, I sleep eight hours, That leaves eight hours for fun.

Hey! He sailed in steerage across the Atlantic, came to Cleveland, where he stayed long enough to work 52 years for the B&O Railroad, before lying down to rest in good Ohio soil. So many of us

here today came from elsewhere, or ancestors did. From Tennessee, Italy, Africa, Asia, Appalachia—even, President Kirwan, the wilds of Kentucky and Maryland. Women and men with backs

supple as birch trunks. The courage it took to pick up stakes and begin again in a new world! Think of the work those older ones did. For you, You all are facing a change right now.

This sheepskin is your passport. You're bound for emigration to the next song of your life. Ohio State is the ark on which you've been sailing. You've been the precious cargo.

But, as Noah once said, I can see clearly now the rain is gone. The ark, our university, was filled to overflowing with the diversity of us. Diversity.

Networks and talk shows devalue the word.

I say, rather, the richness of us, precious difference, the grand multiplicity of selves that balance this globe and enable it to spin true. Grandson of peasant immigrants, I was given

the opportunity to earn a doctorate in English literature from Ohio State—because my family labored long nights around the kitchen table trying to learn this arduous English. I sat where

you're sitting twenty-six years ago.
Bob Dylan and Smokey Robinson got me
through. Yes, it took a prophet and Miracles!
My son earned an OSU Ph.D. in history.
Now you, graduates, are being honored—

by degrees. We've all come together around the kitchen table of Ohio State. Ohio, Round on the ends and high in the middle. For the years to come we'll sing together, Beautiful Ohio,

in dreams again I see, Visions of what used to be. These psalms, sacred thoughts of our tribes, 78's and 33's, tapes, CD's—they take up space in shelves of our skulls, our hearts. They remind us

we want a song beyond the runof-the-mill thrill, the moment throbbing with pleasure or bathed in the blues. We ache for something grander than pure selfishness. Songs sung for one

alone are not true music. Arias shared are music of the spheres, ways of saying to another something from the soul. Of course the Buckeye Battle Cry is there. Drive, drive on down the field,

Men (and women!) of the Scarlet and Gray. Well, you drove on down the field, and you drove up and down the streets, around and around crowded lots, looking for a place to park,

and you searched our dark, ancient library for a decent place to study. My wife, Mary's, father marched in the first "Script Ohio," in 1936. He's here today with us, blowing his horn, I can't help

but feel, as is the sweet mother I lost last year, the one who gave me the stars. Today's music makes us think of the debts we owe, and never can repay. So many of us would not be here

were it not for the lullabyes and songs of dear parents, their parents, theirs. Some are here today in the flesh. Many are not. We mourn them with cadences. of our hearts. Think how many people

sang before us, gave us a name, a voice, taught us the right words. We must cherish them by remembering every song. When we sing to others, we honor our fathers and mothers, thank them

for this day of profound scarlet and gray pomp and circumstance. O, come let's sing Ohio's praise, And songs to Alma Mater raise. Alma mater. Ohio State is our sweet, nurturing mother.

We came of age here, with her help. Well, Mother, we love you, but, like, it's time we moved out, got a place of our own. You're standing there, Mont, gray hair, eyes scarlet

from crying. We won't forget you. Now, even though this ceremony means we're being weaned, taken off the nipple, let's take care to cherish her all our days. Let's remember

the words to the songs she taught us, and pass them on. We'll remember always, Graduation Day. Summer's heat, and winter's cold, The seasons pass, the years will roll, Time and change

will surely show How firm thy friendship, O-hi-O. We call that little number Carmen Ohio. Carmen means song in Latin. You've worked hard; she is your reward; today is your reward.

You're filled to overflowing with the notes, the poems we've written together. You know the score. Continue to work hard for yourselves, and one another. Find the ones who need

you to sing to, for them, in the world. Graduates, this joyful litany, this hymn our ancestors collaborated on with us, the calling of your name today is music to our ears. Sing that name proudly

all your days, as if your life depended on it. It does, you know. It has been an honor for me to speak—and sing to you today. Thank you, graduates, and, again, Congratulations.



Pew Research Center, an independent, non-partisan "fact tank" that generates information on important issues, attitudes, and trends shaping America and the world.

The center's work is carried out by six projects; among them the Pew Research Center for the People and the Press and the Global Attitudes Project, which are Ms. Allen's primary concentrations. The first of these programs serves as a forum for ideas on the media and public policy through public opinion research. The Global Attitudes Project surveys opinion in countries throughout the world, gathering information on attitudes toward the United States, the Muslim world, and other issues of global importance. Both programs serve as an infor-mation resource for political leaders, journalists, scholars, and public interest organizations.

Ms. Allen joined the center from U.S. News and World Report, where she was a managing editor, business editor, senior writer, and author of a bi-weekly column on the political economy. Prior to joining U.S. News, she was the Washington bureau chief at SlateMagazine, Microsoft's online magazine of politics and culture. She has also served as editor of "Outlook," the Sunday commentary section of The Washington Post, and was an editorial writer and business columnist with the Post.

Before beginning her journalism career, Ms. Allen held several government positions, including deputy assistant secretary of labor for policy and research coordinator for family assistance planning in the Nixon administration. Her work in the private sector included national issues coordinator in the Office of the Chair, Chrysler Corporation, and senior vice president of Mathematica Policy Research Inc. She has also held research positions at

the Urban Institute and the Brookings Institute.

Ms. Allen received her bachelor of arts degree with honors from Vassar College. She is a member of Phi Beta Kappa, the Council on Foreign Relations, and the National Academy of Social Insurance,

She is the author of numerous news-paper and magazine articles as well as technical publications and is a contri-butor to the Fortune Encyclopedia of Economics (Warner Books). The Washington Post nominated her editorials on tax policy for a Pulitzer Prize in 1982, and she was a finalist for the Gerald Loeb Award for business and financial commentary in 1989 and 1993.

As a journalist, she was a regular participant on National Public Radio's "Diane Rehm Show" and has appeared on CNN, the BBC, the "Lehrer Newshour," ABC's "Nightline," NBC's "Meet the Press," and Fox News and as a commentator on NPR's "Marketplace."

Frank M. Bass Doctor of Business Administration

rank M. Bass is the Eugene C.
McDermott University of Texas
System Professor of Management
at the University of Texas at Dallas. He
has gained international renown as a
leading scholar in marketing and brand
evolution and as a pioneer in refocusing
business education on core social
science disciplines.

Professor Bass received his bachelor in business administration in 1949 from Southwestern University, his master's in 1950 from the University of Texas, and his doctorate from the University of Illinois in 1954. He began his academic career at the University of Texas, moving to The Ohio State University in 1957 as a tenured associate professor. In 1961 he joined Purdue University's faculty, becoming the Loeb Distinguished Professor of Management in the Krannert Graduate School of Management until 1982, when he moved to the University of Texas.

Throughout his career, Professor Bass has been a prolific researcher, but he is probably best known for a 1969 paper published in Management Science on diffusion of innovations that has become known as the Bass Model. The paper, named one of the "Top Ten Most Influential" papers published in the journal's 50-year history, had an enormous impact on both the academic community and industry and is still used to predict category sales of new durables in their early stages. He has also been a leader in applying science to marketing by using an econometric model for determining the impact of marketing spending on sales.

He is a former president of the Institute of Management Science (now INFORMS, the Institute for Operations Research and Management Sciences) and was named a Fellow of INFORMS in 2002. He has served as associate editor of Management

Science and editor of the Journal of Marketing Research and has won best paper awards for publications in the Journal of Marketing Research and the Journal of Marketing as well as the John D.C. Little award for the best marketing paper in Management Science or Marketing Science. Beginning in 1990, INFORMS' Society for Marketing Science annually awards the Frank M. Bass Award for the Best Doctoral Dissertation Paper in Management Science or Marketing Science.

Among his other awards are the 1986 Paul D. Converse Award for contributions to marketing theory and science, the 2002 Gilbert A. Churchill Award for lifetime achievement in marketing research, and the Charles Coolidge Parlin Award from the American Marketing Association and Wharton School for outstanding contributions to the field of marketing research.

Roger O. McClellan Doctor of Science

oger O. McClellan is currently an advisor to public and private organizations on issues concerned with human health risk analysis, inhalation toxicology, and strategic business analysis for science-based organizations. He is an internationally recognized expert in the field of inhalation toxicology.

Dr. McClellan earned his doctor of veterinary medicine degree with highest honors in 1960 from Washington State University and a master of management from the Anderson Graduate School of Management at the University of New Mexico in 1980. His early career focused on researching the health risks of exposure to fission product radionuclides. In 1966 he joined the Lovelace Foundation for Medical Education and Research in Albuquerque, New Mexico, as assistant director of research and director of the Fission Product Inhalation Program. In 1976 he was named president and director of the Inhalation Toxicology

Research Institute at the Lovelace Biomedical and Environmental Research Institute. Under Dr. McClellan's leadership, the institute grew to achieve international recognition for its research on the health effects of airborne radioactive and chemical toxicants.

In 1988 he became president and chief executive officer of the Chemical Industry Institute of Toxicology (now CIIT Centers for Health Research) in Research Triangle Park, North Carolina. At the time of Dr. McClellan's retirement in 1999, the institute had a multi-disciplinary staff of 25 doctoral-degreed scientists, 100 support personnel, 25 postdoctoral fellows, and 15 co-op or pre-doctoral students and was known worldwide for its contributions to reducing the scientific uncertainty in making decisions concerning the human health risks of exposure to contaminants.

Dr. McClellan has authored or coauthored more than 350 scientific papers and has edited or co-edited 10 books in

the fields of inhalation toxicology, comparative medicine, and human health risk analysis. He has served on the adjunct faculty of eight academic institutions and on the advisory committees for six federal agencies, including the executive committee of the Science Advisory board for the Environmental Protection Agency. He continues to be one of the most sought after advisors in the field of environmental toxicology in the United States and abroad.

Dr. McClellan's many honors include, among others, election to the Institute of Medicine of the National Academy of Science, the International Achievement Award from the International Society of Regulatory Toxicology and Pharmacology, the International Aerosol Fellow Award from the International Aerosol Research Assembly, the Society of Toxicology's 2005 Merit Award, and the Department of Energy's Distinguished Associate Award.

Grayce McVeigh Sills Doctor of Public Service

rayce McVeigh Sills is professor emeritus of nursing at The Ohio State University College of Nursing and an internationally recognized leader in the field of psychiatric nursing.

The Ohio native received her nursing diploma in 1950 from Rockland State Hospital School of Nursing in Orangeburg, New York. Shortly after graduation, she entered a graduate program at Columbia University where she met Hildegard Peplau, a faculty member who became her mentor and colleague in developing a new method of teaching psychiatric nursing. Professor Sills received her bachelor of science in nursing from the University of Dayton in 1956 and a master's degree and doctorate in sociology from The Ohio State University in 1964 and 1968, respectively.

Professor Sills joined Ohio State's School of Nursing in 1964 as an assistant professor, becoming full professor in 1972. During her 27-year tenure at the

university, she served as faculty member, department chair, director of graduate studies, and acting dean and was instrumental in raising the school to college status and in developing one of the nation's top graduate programs in nursing. She continues to be actively involved with Ohio State following her 1991 retirement, recently serving as chair of the University Hospital board of trustees and currently as coordinator of a pilot program in Interdisciplinary Behavioral Health Training for OSU Harding Hospital.

During her career, she has served as visiting professor at the University of New Mexico School of Nursing, Rutgers Graduate School of Nursing, Oregon Health Sciences University, Indiana University School of Nursing, Case Western Reserve University's Bolton School of Nursing, and Fairfield University School of Nursing. She has published more than 50 articles in scholarly journals and has recorded 15 educational videotapes, produced by the American Journal of Nursing Company. She is sought as an invited speaker and consultant and has given countless presentations to professional and public groups nationwide.

Professor Sills' commitment to nursing education and to improving care for the chronically mentally ill has been recognized with a number of honors, including the 2000 Hildegard Peplau Award for contributions to psychiatric nursing from the American Nurses Association, the American Academy of Nursing's Living Legend Award, induction into the YWCA of Columbus Academy of Women Achievers, and the Ohio Alliance for the Mentally Ill Professional of the Year, among many others. In 1988 Governor Richard Celeste named her chair of the five-year Study Committee on Mental Health Services for the state of Ohio.

Anne S. Pruitt-Logan Distinguished Service Award

nne S. Pruitt-Logan is professor emeritus of educational policy and leadership at The Ohio State University. During her 17-year tenure at Ohio State, she also served as associate dean of the Graduate School, associate provost, and director of the Center for Teaching Excellence.

Dr. Pruitt-Logan received her bachelor's degree in psychology from Howard University, earned a master's and doctorate at Teachers College, Columbia University, and received postdoctoral training in administration through an American Council on Education Fellowship. The Regents of the University System of Georgia subsidized her 1949 matriculation at Columbia with funds set aside for African American citizens who, because of their race, were not permitted at the time to study at the University of Georgia.

Prior to joining the Ohio State faculty in 1979, becoming the university's first African American woman full professor, Dr. Pruitt-Logan served as professor of education at Case Western Reserve University and previously in positions as dean of students and dean of women at Fisk University and Albany (Georgia) State College.

Following her 1995 retirement from Ohio State, she served for eight years at the Council of Graduate Schools as dean in residence, then scholar in residence. During this time, she co-directed a new nationwide program, "Preparing Future Faculty," an initiative to stimulate the reform of doctoral education for the professoriate. She served as primary investigator for more than \$3 million of the program's grants to extend PFF into the preparation of future science, mathematics, humanities, and social science faculty.

From the start of her career, she has focused on improving access to education for underserved populations. From 1979 to 1985, as associate dean of Ohio State's Graduate School, she worked to increase federal support for minorities and women to enter nontraditional fields such as engineering and mathematics. She also held

major consultancies with the Southern Regional Education Board and the Southern Education Foundation to dismantle the dual segregated system of higher education.

Significant developments during her tenure as director of the university's Center for Teaching Excellence include the video presentation titled "Teaching for Black Student Retention," the first interdisciplinary National Conference for Graduate Teaching Assistants and the organization of the Academy of Teaching, composed of Ohio State faculty members who have won Distinguished Teaching and Distinguished Scholar Awards.

Dr. Pruitt-Logan has authored or coauthored numerous scholarly publications. She has served as a member of the boards of trustees at Central State University and Case Western Reserve University and, in 1976, became the first African American president of the American College Personnel Association.

Richard Ramsay Stander, Sr. Distinguished Service Award

ichard Ramsay Stander, Sr., is chair of the Mohican Construction Company and former president of Mansfield Asphalt Paving Company. He is a longtime business and civic leader in the Mansfield area.

He received his bachelor of civil engineering degree from The Ohio State University in 1940. Following graduation, he spent a year in the testing lab of the Ohio Department of highways, followed by five years on the Army Corps of Engineers' research and development board.

In 1946 Mr. Stander joined Mansfield Asphalt Paving Company, becoming president of the firm in 1956. By that year he was also president of the Mohican Trucking Company, founder and president of the Mohican Construction Company, and vice president of the Fredericktown Sand and Gravel Company.

As a community leader, he was, and is, a strong advocate for his hometown, his profession, and his alma mater. As president of the Ohio Contractors
Association, he was instrumental in
establishing a continuing education
program that was beneficial for Ohio
State's Colleges of Business and
Engineering and for hundreds of
highway contractor employees. A
member of the National Academy of
Sciences' Transportation Research board,
he was also a 14-year member of the
board of directors for the Transportation
Research Center of Ohio, formerly
operated by the College of Engineering.

In the early 1960s, when the Ohio legislature authorized the building of a branch campus of Ohio State in Mansfield, Mr. Stander and his father, Carl H. Stander, donated 50 acres of land to begin the new campus. He recently has donated another 31 acres adjacent to the growing Mansfield campus. Following the initial land donation, Mr. Stander spearheaded a fund-raising drive to buy the rest of the land to complete the new campus and

served as founding president of the Citizens' Advisory Council (now the Mansfield Campus board of trustees). He was also a trustee of the Mansfield University Foundation for 30 years and served as the Mansfield Campus representative to the Alumni Advisory board.

An early member of the Presidents Club and a longtime executive committee member of the College of Engineering's Committee of 100, he was recognized in 1970 with the College of Engineering's Distinguished Alumni Award and the University Centennial Award.

He recently was the recipient of the George S. Bartlett Award from the Transportation Research board of the National Academy of Sciences, the American Road and Transportation Builders Association, and the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials for his role in the development of the Interstate Highway System.





with Honors in the Arts and Sciences requires successful completion of the Arts and Sciences Honors Contract and rank in the top 25% of the class.







he colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings called for caps and floorlength capes with attached hoods, and the sobering influence of the church probably influenced the staid character of the caps and gowns.

As the control of the universities gradually passed from the church, some

aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. Old prints and engravings, however, reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and that of the present day.

In light of our nation's English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity in regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed to prepare a code for caps, gowns, and hoods that has since been adopted by all academic institutions.

Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the familiar mortarboard square—

a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it covers any dress that might indicate rank or social status. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctoral and master's degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the university.

The Gown

Bachelor: The bachelor gown is black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master: The master gown is black, long or short sleeves, with an arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor: The Ohio State University Doctor of Philosophy gown is scarlet with gray velvet panels on the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Other doctor gowns are black with velvet panels and bars, the color of which is distinctive of the field of study.

Honors Emblem

The Ohio State University honors emblem is a scarlet and gray tasseled braid worn over the gown. Students eligible for this curricular honor are those graduating summa cum laude, magna cum laude, cum laude, with distinction, and with honors.

The Hood

Bachelor: Three feet long with a two-inch-wide velvet edging.*

Master: Three and one-half feet long with a three-inch-wide velvet edging.

Doctor: Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet edging and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree. The color of the velvet indicates the field of study.


Cap and Tassel

THE LONG WALK

In 1893, the master plan for The Ohio State University campus proposed a group of buildings around a central open space. The first reference to this area as "the Oval" was around 1910. A year later, a very elaborate, geometric pattern of walks within the Oval was added to the plan. This included a lengthy east-west walk—today anchored on the west end by the William Oxley Thompson Library and on the east end by Page Hall and the Wexner Center for the Arts. By 1919-20, and possibly earlier, this came to be known as the "Long Walk." In the early years, freshmen were forbidden to be on the Long Walk. The penalty—occasionally enforced by upperclass students—was to be thrown into Mirror Lake.

As one of Ohio State's most notable landmarks, the Oval is a key aspect of the university's identity, as well as a hub of its active daily life.

In June 2004, a major restoration project got underway to ensure the Oval's historic character while, at the same time, to address the contemporary needs of the campus. Walkway replacement, an irrigation system, new turf, and new lighting will all help preserve the Oval's integrity and make the area better able to withstand and accommodate a wide variety of student activities and special events. The construction project was completed in June 2005.
