

Commencement Speaker

Daryle H. Busch

Daryle H. Busch, professor of chemistry, has been a faculty member since receiving his Ph.D. from the University of Illinois in 1954. He specializes in transition metal and bio-inorganic chemistry and has recently done ground-breaking work in synthetic iron chemistry. In 1980, he was honored as an outstanding teacher with the University's Alumni Award for Distinguished Teaching, and in 1981 received the Distinguished Research Award. His numerous other awards include the 1978 Dwyer Medal of the Chemical Society of New South Wales, Australia, and he is one of only three people to receive both of the American Chemical Society's awards in inorganic chemistry. He was elected a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science in 1980 and currently serves on the editorial boards of several chemistry journals.

Recipients of Honors

W. Edwards Deming

Doctor of Science

In an era marked by increasing complexity, Dr. W. Edwards Deming is one of a handful of people who have made it possible for business, industry, and government to manage the tasks of industrial societies effectively. A highly sought-after and eminent statistician, Dr. Deming is known throughout the world for his contributions to the creation and use of statistics. His work in statistics helped make possible the United States' rapid mobilization during World War II as well as Japan's miraculous recovery in the post-war period. Japan has recognized his contribution to its remarkable economic growth by striking a medal in his honor. The W. Edwards Deming Medal is awarded to the company which has made the most significant advances in productivity and product quality. Dr. Deming has served as a consultant to many foreign governments and the United Nations and has lectured at universities in Europe and South America. Committed to a more productive and humane workplace, he has helped make possible higher living standards for people around the globe. The University is privileged to honor Dr. Deming for his pioneering work in statistics.

Ferdinand Fairfax Stone

Doctor of Humane Letters

Ohio State has a long tradition of academic excellence. This tradition is best demonstrated by its graduates and the contributions they have made to society and their professions. Ferdinand Stone is a shining example of this tradition. Dr. Stone is an internationally recognized authority on comparative law and the only living Rhodes Scholar from The Ohio State University.

After completing his B.A. in English and his M.A. in political science at Ohio State, he attended Oxford in 1931 and from there went on to receive his doctoral degree in juristic science from Yale University.

Awarded an honorary degree from the University of Grenoble by Charles DeGaulle, he was also named an honorary officer in the "Most Excellent Order of the British Empire" by Queen Elizabeth II. Dr. Stone has lectured at universities throughout Europe, authored four books—including the first textbook in French on American law—and has written over forty scholarly articles and other publications. The founder and first director of Tulane University's Institute of Comparative Law, he was Scholar in Residence at Tulane's Law School, where he taught for over forty years before retiring in 1979. Today, the University takes great pride in honoring one of its most distinguished graduates for his contributions to jurisprudence and comparative law.

Barbara W. Tuchman

Doctor of Humane Letters (presented in absentia)

The most widely known and generally respected non-academic historian in the United States, Barbara Tuchman has brought the drama, experience, and value of history to a wide audience. An internationally recognized writer, journalist, and advocate of humanistic values, Mrs. Tuchman is a living tribute to the value of a liberal education. She received her B.A. degree from Radcliffe College in 1933 and went on to pursue a journalistic and literary career. A prolific and versatile author, she has written nine books including two Pulitzer Prize winners, *The Guns of August* and *Stilwell and the American Experience in China, 1911-1945*. Over the last two and a half decades she has contributed regularly to a number of leading journals of opinion, including *American Heritage*, *Atlantic Monthly*, *Harper's*, and *the Nation*. Her articles, like her books, vary in subject matter, from medieval history to contemporary politics and culture. Mrs. Tuchman has long been a leader in American arts and letters and is a member of the Authors League of America and the Society of American Historians. She is a former president of the American Institute and Academy of Arts and Letters and a recipient of its prized Gold Medal. In bestowing this honor on Mrs. Tuchman, the University seeks to recognize and thank her for her many contributions to the arts and humanities.

Robert C. Ringer

Distinguished Service Award

For 35 years Robert C. Ringer provided a compassionate ear and a helping hand to the faculty and staff of this University. Many can recall his leadership of the University's Payroll Office. For nearly 20 years he guided it through periods of great growth and technical and administrative changes. Later, as a special assistant to the Vice President for Personnel Services, he continued to strive to improve the quality of an Ohio State University career. Instrumental in developing the Retirement Affairs section of Personnel Services, he added the personal touch to a program designed to help faculty and staff plan and process their retirements. Today, and later, you may ask what you can do for the University. There seems to be



To you, your families, friends, and those others who helped you arrive here today go our congratulations. You are joining a great family of Ohio State alumni working together to make a difference.



The Academic Costume

The colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University Commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics as well, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings made caps and floor-length capes with attached hoods a necessity for warmth. Probably because of the costumes' religious heritage, they remained drab until the universities gradually began to pass from the control of the Church, whereupon some aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. However, old prints and engravings reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and the academic costume worn today.

In light of our nation's strong English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity with regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed which prepared a code for caps, gowns, and hoods, which has been adopted by all institutions. Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the more familiar mortarboard square—a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship for it covers any dress which might indicate rank or social status. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctor's degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the University.

The Gown

Bachelor Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.
Master Black, long or short sleeves with arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.
Doctor Black with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

The Hood

Bachelor Three feet in length with a two-inch-wide velvet edging.*
Master Three and one-half feet in length with a three-inch-wide velvet edging.*
Doctor Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet edging and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution from which the degree was received. The color of the velvet indicates the field in which the doctoral was granted:
