Commencement Speaker

Edwin D. Dodd Doctor of Business Management

Throughout his distinguished life, Edwin D. Dodd has demonstrated continued excellence. While studying for his B.A. in business administration at Ohio State, he participated in Ohio Staters Inc., Sphinx, Strollers, and the Student Senate. Dodd went on to earn a master's degree in industrial administration at Harvard. During World War II, he rose to the rank of major and was a member of General MacArthur's Pacific staff. As a businessman, he achieved national prominence with Owens-Illinois in Toledo. Joining the company as a public relations representative, he went on to become president, chief executive officer, and chairman before his retirement in 1984. Dodd received the Phoenix Award in 1974 for leadership in the glass container industry and was honored as "Packaging Man of the Year" in 1977 by the Packaging Education Association. He has been chairman of the United States Chamber of Commerce and is a member of the National Corporations Committee of the United Negro College Fund. He was asked to serve on President Reagan's Commission on Industrial Competitiveness and was appointed to national commissions by former Presidents Carter and Nixon.

Dodd has been a leader in the revitalization of downtown Toledo and in many other civic efforts there. He has served Ohio State as a member of the Alumni Advisory Council and as chairman of the Development Fund Board of Directors. His alma mater takes pride in recognizing his achievements.

Recipients of Honors

Eva Crane Doctor of Science

Because of rationing and a severe shortage of sugar in England during World War II, Eva Crane became interested in apiculture—commonly known as beekeeping. Crane, whose academic training was in mathematics and physics, began a career that would cause her to be regarded as the world's most distinguished apiculturist. In 1949 she became director of the Bee Research Association in England. She was its sole employee, and it was housed in her own home. Under her guidance the organization grew into the International Bee Research Association. This association is recognized internationally as the center for world knowledge about developments in beekeeping and research on bees and their products.

Until her retirement as director in 1983, Crane edited three journals, one of which she founded. She has written or edited 22 books and has published several hundred articles and other publications. Her worldwide travels—including visits to Ohio State—enabled her to share her knowledge extensively, while eliminating national barriers to research and fostering cooperation among scientists. Through her position as chairperson of the First International Conference on Apiculture in Tropical Climates, she has helped to expand apiculture and increase food production in many developing countries. Ohio's leadership in apiculture and Ohio State's highly regarded apiculture program combine to make this honor for Eva Crane most fitting.

Torsten Husén Doctor of Higher Education

Viewed by many to be the major educational figure in Scandinavia, Torsten Husén has achieved an international reputation for his work in comparative education. Husén, professor emeritus at the University of Stockholm, has studied and acquired an understanding of education in countries around the world. In his native Sweden, his research has influenced that country's entire educational system. Through the International Association for the Evaluation of Educational Achievement, which he helped found in 1962, he made possible a collection of data that compared learning among students in more than 50 nations. This data benefited educational policy makers for a quarter of a century.

Husén is the author of some 40 books, and is currently coeditor of the *International Encyclopedia of Education: Research and Studies*. He has been chairman of the governing board of the International Institute for Educational Planning and a member of the board of trustees and executive committee of the International Council for Educational Development. Husén is a foreign associate of the National Academy of Education, has taught at several major universities in the United States, and has been a fellow of the Center for Advanced Study in the Behavioral Sciences and the National Humanities Center. He currently serves on the Nobel Prize nominating commission. Ohio State proudly recognizes this distinguished educator.

Recipients of Honors

Myrl H. Shoemaker

Doctor of Laws

When names of exemplary public servants in the state of Ohio are recorded, Myrl H. Shoemaker will surely appear on the list. This lifelong Ross County resident has spent nearly 50 years serving his community and home state through elected office. He served for 22 years as a member and clerk-treasurer of the Twin Rural and Paint Valley local school districts. He then went on to spend 23 years as a member of the Ohio House of Representatives. During that time he was chairman of the House Finance-Appropriations Committee and a member of all other major committees. Shoemaker was a member of the State Controlling Board, the Emergency Board, and the Legislative Service Commission. In 1982, his public service career entered a new phase when he was elected as Ohio's lieutenant governor. Not content to limit his efforts to a single governmental capacity, he was appointed by Governor Richard F. Celeste to the additional position of director of the Ohio Department of Natural Resources. He remains active in the civic affairs of his home community of Bournerville, where he is a member of the Farm Bureau, the Conservation League, and the Concerned Citizens for the Handicapped. Ohio State is proud to honor this distinguished native son.







The Academic Costume

The colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University Commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings called for caps and floor-length capes with attached hoods, and the sobering influence of the church probably influenced the staid character of the caps and gowns.

As the control of the universities gradually passed from the church, some aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. Old prints and engravings, however, reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and that of the present day.

In light of our nation's English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity in regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed to prepare a code for caps, gowns, and hoods that has since been adopted by all academic institutions.

Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the familiar mortarboard square—a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship for it covers any dress that might indicate rank or social status. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctoral degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the University.

The Gown

Bachelor. Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master. Black, long or short sleeves with arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor. Black with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

The Hood

Bachelor. Three feet long with a two-inch-wide velvet edging.*

Master. Three and one-half feet long with a three-inch-wide velvet edging.*

Doctor. Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet edging and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the

official colors of the institution granting the degree. The color of the velvet indicates the field of study:
