Commencement Address

Martha McMackin Garland

Martha McMackin Garland, associate professor of history at The Ohio State University, is a respected scholar, outstanding teacher, and creative administrator.

A native of Salem, Illinois, she received her bachelor's degree in history from Tulane University and the University of London and earned her master's degree in medieval history from Cornell University. Dr. Garland joined Ohio State's faculty in 1975 as a lecturer in the Department of History. She received her doctoral degree in modern British history that same year and became an associate professor at Ohio State in 1988.

Now associate dean for instruction and curriculum in the College of Humanities, Dr. Garland has served in a variety of administrative posts, including counselor and head of the premedical program in the Colleges of the Arts and Sciences from 1977-79; assistant, then associate director of the Office of Continuing Education from 1979-82; and undergraduate chair of the Department of History from 1992-93.

Dr. Garland has had a far-reaching influence on university matters through her extensive committee work. She served as chair for several key committees, including the College of Humanities Curriculum Committee, 1988-90; the Distinguished Staff Award Selection Committee, 1994; and the University Committee on the Undergraduate Experience, 1994-95. In 1992-93, she chaired the steering committee of the University Senate, the principal governance body representing faculty, students, and staff. In addition, she works with the University Honors Center and teaches honors European history.

Her teaching specialty is modern British history, particularly the social and cultural history of the late Victorian period. Much of her work focuses on the widespread loss of faith at the end of the 19th century. Her numerous publications and presentations include the book *Cambridge Before Darwin: The Ideal of a Liberal Education, 1800-1860*, published by the Cambridge University Press.

She is a member of the American Historical Association, the North American Conference on British Studies, the Social History Society of the United Kingdom, the Midwest Conference on British Studies, the Midwest Victorian Studies Association, and the Ohio Academy of History.

Recipients of Honors

Virginia Hamilton Doctor of Humane Letters

One of the premier authors of children's literature in the world today, Virginia Hamilton has won universal acclaim as a fiction writer, anthologist, and biographer.

Since the 1967 publication of her first book, *Zeely*, she has won every national and international prize awarded to writers of English-language children's books. She was the first African American to win the prestigious John Newbery Medal, given for "the most distinguished contribution to American literature for children." Her 1974 book, *M. C. Higgins, The Great*, is the only book to win the Newbery Medal, the Boston Globe-Horn Book Award, and the National Book Award—the three most prestigious U. S. awards for children's books.

In 1992, Ms. Hamilton became one of only four American authors to win the Hans Christian Andersen Author Award, given by the International Board of Books for Young Children (IBBY) for the body of her work. IBBY cited her "profound humanity, breathtaking depth and complexity, and innovative and poetic use of language, especially the vernacular of Black America."

She has published 31 books to date, including fiction, folktale collections, biographies, and historical works for both children and adults. Her most recent work, published in 1993, is *Many Thousand Gone: African Americans from Slavery to Freedom*, a carefully researched history of slavery in the United States from the 17th century slave trade to the Emancipation Proclamation.

The granddaughter of a slave who escaped to Ohio from Virginia on the Underground Railroad, Ms. Hamilton has spent most of her life on her family's land in Yellow Springs, Ohio. She attended Antioch College from 1952-55 and Ohio State from 1957-58. She has also studied American literature at the New School for Social Research in New York City.

A sought-after lecturer and teacher, Ms. Hamilton served as a Distinguished Visiting Professor at Ohio State in 1988-89 and at Queens College, New York City, in 1986-87. An annual lecture, The Virginia Hamilton Lecture in Children's Literature, was established at Kent State University in 1984.

Ohio State proudly adds its recognition to the many deserved honors already bestowed on this distinguished woman of letters.

Torsten N. Wiesel Doctor of Science

Torsten N. Wiesel is recognized as one of the great neuroscientists of this century. Together with his colleague David H. Hubel, he received the 1981 Nobel Prize in Physiology and Medicine for revolutionary work on the visual processing mechanisms of the brain.

A native of Sweden, Dr. Wiesel received his medical degree from the Karolinska Institute in Stockholm in 1954. He served briefly on the institute's staff before taking an ophthalmology fellowship at the Johns Hopkins University Medical School in Baltimore. In 1959, he joined the Harvard Medical School faculty as an associate in neurophysiology and neuropharmacology. He remained at Harvard for 24 years, becoming chairman of the department of neurobiology in 1973.

In 1983 he was named Vincent & Brooke Astor Professor and Head of the Laboratory of Neurobiology at the Rockefeller University in New York City. In 1992 he became president of that institution.

The pioneering research of Wiesel and Hubel showed that remarkable progress can be made in understanding brain function by studying the responses of individual nerve cells. Prior to their studies, it was assumed that the visual cortex was so complex that little could be learned from studying individual cells. However, their research showed that individual cells have very specific properties, responding to a wide variety of stimuli.

Professor Wiesel's studies with Hubel and his recent research on myopia have considerable relevance to the clinical care of vision patients and have contributed in a major way to the current dramatic development of the neurosciences.

He has published more than 80 articles in scholarly journals and has received numerous honors and awards for his work, including honorary degrees from universities in the United States and abroad.

His memberships include the American Physiology Society, the American Association for the Advancement of Science, the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, the Society for Neuroscience (President, 1978-79), and the National Academy of Science, among others.

It is with great pride that Ohio State honors this eminent scholar, researcher, and teacher.



The Academic Costume

The colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University Commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings called for caps and floor-length capes with attached hoods, and the sobering influence of the church probably influenced the staid character of the caps and gowns.

As the control of the universities gradually passed from the church, some aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. Old prints and engravings, however, reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and that of the present day.

In the light of our nation's English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity in regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed to prepare a code for caps, gowns, and hoods that has since been adopted by all academic institutions.

Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the familiar mortarboard square—a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship for it covers any dress that might indicate rank or social status. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctoral degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the University.

The Gown

Bachelor. Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master. Black, long or short sleeves with a re-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor. Black with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

The Hood

Bachelor. Three feet long with a two-inch-wide velvet edging.*

Master. Three and one-half feet long with a three-inch-wide velvet edging.*

Doctor. Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet edging and panel at the sides.

* Not usually worn by candidates for a degree.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree. The color of the velvet indicates the field of study:
