

David L. Brennan

David L. Brennan is this year's chair of The Ohio State University Board of Trustees. He is chair of Brennan Industrial Group, Inc., and The Brenlin Group, Inc., both private holding companies of industrial and manufacturing entities headquartered in Akron; founder of Brennan Manna and Diamond LLC law firm; and chair of White Hat Management LLC.

A native of Akron, Mr. Brennan graduated from Ohio State in 1953 and earned his J.D. degree from Case Western Reserve University School of Law in 1957, where he also serves as a trustee.

In his experience as a manufacturing executive, Mr. Brennan became aware of the deficiencies of the American

educational system and established learning centers at his manufacturing and industrial sites to help his employees and their families overcome gaps in their educational backgrounds and increase their capacity for success.

In 1992, he was appointed by Ohio Governor George Voinovich to head a blue-ribbon commission on education, the report of which led to significant new opportunities in educational choice across Ohio, including the Cleveland voucher program. In 1997, he received The Governor's Award for his unique contributions in the field of education.

In 1998, Mr. Brennan founded White Hat Management, a professional educational services firm, which has

helped institute 16 new charter schools in Ohio, including eight elementary schools and eight LifeSkills high school programs. LifeSkills works with high school dropouts, helping them gain high school diplomas and on-the-job experience.

Mr. Brennan has served as a consultant to public and private schools, sectarian and nonsectarian schools, voucher schools, and charter schools, helping develop private and public scholarship funds and programs for needy children in urban school districts throughout the state.

Wilford Robert Gardner

Doctor of Science

Wilford Robert Gardner is dean and professor emeritus of soil physics at the University of California, Berkeley, and adjunct professor of soil physics at Utah State University in Logan, Utah.

A native of Utah, he received his B.S. in physics and mathematics from Utah State University in 1949 and an M.S. and Ph.D. in soil physics, physics, and mathematics from Iowa State University in 1951 and 1953, respectively. After service in the U.S. Army from 1943 to 1946, he joined the physics faculty at Iowa State. In 1953, he joined the U.S. Salinity Laboratory in Riverside, California, as a soil physicist, serving there until 1966. He then accepted a position as professor of soil and environmental physics at the University of Wisconsin from 1966 to 1980. From 1980 to 1987, he served as head of the Department of Soil and Water Science at the University of Arizona. In 1987, he

was named dean and professor of soil physics at Berkeley until his 1994 retirement.

His career, spanning half a century, led to pioneering work in soil physics, water movement in soil, and sustainable management of soil and water resources. He is internationally known for his research on water and solute movement and the processes governing transport of chemicals into natural waters from agricultural ecosystems. His coauthored work, *Soil Physics*, is the standard textbook for advanced students in the field. In addition, he has written 140 scientific publications and 17 monograph chapters. He has traveled extensively throughout the world as an invited speaker and consultant.

Professor Gardner is one of only two soil scientists to be elected to the National Academy of Sciences. He is a

fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, the American Society of Agronomy, and the Soil Science Society of America and has been a member of various National Research Council study committees. He chairs the Finance Committee of the International Union of Soil Science and the National Committee on Soil Science of the U.S. National Academy of Sciences. Under his guidance, the NAS committee is planning the 18th World Congress of Soil Science to be held in the United States in 2006.

He is the recipient of numerous honors, including the Faculty Medal of Honor from the University of Ghent, Belgium, the Utah State University 1988 Centennial Alumnus Award, and an honorary professorship in the Chinese Academy of Soil Science in Nanjing. In 1990, he served as president of the Soil Science Society of America.

Theodore M. Hesburgh

Doctor of Humane Letters

Theodore M. Hesburgh is president emeritus of the University of Notre Dame, having held that position from 1952 to 1987.

A native of Syracuse, New York, Father Hesburgh was educated at Notre Dame and the Gregorian University in Rome, from which he received a bachelor of philosophy degree in 1939. He was ordained a priest of the Congregation of Holy Cross in 1943 and continued his study of sacred theology at the Catholic University of America, receiving his doctorate (S.T.D.) in 1945.

He joined the University of Notre Dame religion faculty in 1945 and became department chair in 1948. The following year he was appointed executive vice president and in 1952, at the age of 35, he was named the 15th president of the university. Among the major changes during his tenure were the changeover to lay governance in 1967 and the advent of undergraduate

coeducation in 1972. Following his retirement, Father Hesburgh returned to an office in Notre Dame's Hesburgh Library, where in 1990 he completed his autobiography, *God, Country, Notre Dame*, which became a national bestseller.

He continues to be active in university matters and advancing the interests of several Notre Dame academic institutes, including the KROC Institute for International Peace Studies and the Kellogg Institute for International Studies. He is also actively involved in the university's Center for Civil and Human Rights, its Environmental Research Center in Wisconsin, and its Ecumenical Institute in Jerusalem.

Among his recent endeavors is co-chairing the Knight Commission on Intercollegiate Athletics, studying reform of college sports. He also chairs a number of fund-raising activities for Catholic and higher education causes.

Father Hesburgh's public service

career has included 16 presidential appointments, involving him in virtually all major social issues, such as civil rights, peaceful uses of atomic energy, campus unrest, Third World development, and immigration reform. He has remained a national leader in the field of education, serving on numerous commissions and study groups. As chair of the International Federation of Catholic Universities from 1963 to 1970, he led a movement to redefine the nature and mission of the contemporary Catholic university.

He is the recipient of the 2000 Congressional Gold Medal, the U.S. Congress' highest civilian honor, and the Medal of Freedom, the nation's highest civilian honor, awarded in 1964. He is a member of the National Academy of Sciences, a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, and a member of the American Philosophical Society.

Ray D. Owen

Doctor of Science

Ray D. Owen is professor emeritus of biology at the California Institute of Technology, where he served for nearly four decades before his 1983 retirement.

A native of Wisconsin, he grew up on a dairy farm, an experience that shaped his career as a geneticist and immunologist. He received his B.S. degree from Carroll College in Wisconsin in 1937 and his Ph.D. from the University of Wisconsin, Madison, in 1941. While serving as assistant professor of genetics and zoology at Wisconsin, he began his research on dairy cattle blood group inheritance and, in 1945, published a groundbreaking paper in the journal *Science* on his discovery that blood cells could be transferred *in utero* between nonidentical twin calves. His discovery led to the theory of acquired immunological tolerance, which has major significance in the modern-day field of clinical organ transplants.

In 1946, Professor Owen accepted a position as associate professor at the

California Institute of Technology, becoming full professor in 1953, chair of the Division of Biology in 1961, and dean of students and vice president for student affairs in 1975. Among his many accomplishments during his administrative tenure at Caltech is his chairing a committee to improve the freshman-year experience, which led to the inauguration of a pass/fail grading system for freshmen, the introduction of electives into the first-year curriculum, and the admission of women.

His research through the years has earned him a reputation as one of the world's foremost biological scientists, and he has mentored and inspired numerous students who have themselves become distinguished contributors in genetics and transplantation. He has published numerous research papers, mainly in the field of mammalian genetics and immunology and in such areas as tissue and organ transplantation and developmental studies. His textbook, coauthored with Adrian

Srb of Cornell University, *General Genetics*, was for many years the most-used textbook in the field.

He is a member of the National Academy of Sciences, the American Philosophical Society, and the American Academy of Arts and Sciences. He served as president of the Genetics Society of America, as a board member of the American Society of Human Genetics, and as a member of the editorial board of the *Annual Review of Genetics*. He has held numerous leadership positions at the national level, and, as a member of the President's Cancer Panel, he advised Presidents Nixon and Ford.

In recognition of Professor Owen's pioneering contributions to the field of transplantation, the Transplantation Society awarded him the Sir Peter Medawar Prize at its congress in Rome in August 2000. Medawar, a Nobel Laureate, credited Professor Owen with the initial research that led to Medawar's Nobel Prize for his studies on immunological tolerance in mice.

David W. Cole

Distinguished Service Award

David W. Cole is professor emeritus of finance in the Max M. Fisher College of Business at The Ohio State University. He currently serves as chair of the Fisher College of Business New Buildings Committee and as academic director of the Academy for Financial Executives.

Professor Cole, who joined the Ohio State faculty in 1965, earned a B.A. in business from Capital University in 1960, an M.B.A. in finance from Ohio University in 1962, and a D.B.A. in finance from Indiana University in 1965. He served as chair of the Faculty of Finance in the Fisher College from 1971 to 1978.

In 1969, Professor Cole received The Ohio State University Alumni Award for Distinguished Teaching and is a three-time recipient of the College of Business' Outstanding Teaching Award. In 1993, he was selected as one of the 100 founding members of Ohio State's

Academy of Teaching, and that same year he was awarded the Fisher College of Business Distinguished Service Award.

In 1992, he inaugurated Ohio State's Academy for Financial Executives, an intensive two-year executive education program for members of top management of commercial banks and thrifts. Since 1991, he has served as Ohio State's representative to Russia six times, delivering banking and small business seminars, and he was instrumental in developing the business curriculum at three colleges and universities in Tomsk, Siberia.

With Professor Emeritus Ronald Racster, his responsibilities with the Fisher College's New Buildings Committee include working with the faculty, staff, and students, the University Architect's Office, the State of Ohio, and the associate architects in developing requirements and designing

the new 390,000-square-foot, six-building campus for the college, due for completion this spring. Over the past seven years, he has visited 25 colleges, business schools, and executive education centers to obtain firsthand knowledge of the strengths and weaknesses of alternative classroom and office designs.

An active participant in management education programs, Professor Cole serves as a faculty member of the Pacific Coast Banking School, the Bank Administration Institute (BAI) Graduate School of Community Bank Management, the BAI Graduate School of Retail Banking, and the BAI Graduate School of Financial Management. He has published numerous articles and cases relating to the financial management of commercial banks and thrifts and has worked with more than 100 financial firms in developing in-house financial education programs and facilitating strategic planning.

Ronald L. Racster

Distinguished Service Award

Ronald L. Racster is professor emeritus of real estate and finance at The Ohio State University, codirector of The Max M. Fisher College of Business Center for Real Estate Education and Research, and vice-chair of the Fisher College of Business New Buildings Committee.

He is president and director of the Homer Hoyt Institute, a nonprofit corporation in North Palm Beach, Florida, which promotes useful, practical real estate research. He is a founding fellow, dean, and faculty member of the institute's Weimer School of Advanced Studies in Real Estate and Land Economics. In addition, he is director and officer of the Homer Hoyt Advanced Studies Institute, Inc., and Hoyt Advisory Services.

Professor Racster received his B.A. in economics in 1958, his M.S. in finance in 1962, and his Ph.D. in finance in


1967 from the University of Illinois. He joined Ohio State's business faculty in 1968 and served as director of the Ohio Real Estate Institute in the College of Business' Division of Continuing Education from 1970 to 1983. He was a member of the University Investments Committee from 1984 to his retirement in 1995. He also served as chair of the college's Faculty of Finance from 1980 to 1984, academic associate dean and director of Undergraduate Business Programs from 1986 to 1993, chair of the college's Blue Ribbon Committee for Strategic Planning from 1991 to 1992, and co-chair of the Creative Learning Task Force from 1992 to 1995.

Nationally sought as an expert consultant and speaker on real estate, Professor Racster is coauthor and contributing author to textbooks on real estate and urban land economics, real estate market analysis, and real estate

appraisal. He has written several articles in academic journals and has served as a reviewer for real estate and related academic and professional journals and publishers. He is the recipient of the 1993 George Bloom Award given by the officers and directors of the American Real Estate and Urban Economics Association for outstanding contributions to the field of real estate.

Along with Professor Emeritus David Cole of the business faculty, Professor Racster has overseen, as owner representative, the continuing construction of the 390,000-square-foot, six-building complex for the Fisher College of Business. Their efforts have ensured that the Fisher College is one of the most effective and visually stimulating classroom, office, and executive residence facilities in the nation. The complex, begun in 1998, is due for completion this spring.



Cum Laude designates those graduating with a 3.5 GPA or better.



With Distinction requires successful completion of a Senior Honors Thesis and graduation with a 3.3 GPA or better.

THE ACADEMIC COSTUME

The colorful ceremonies of The Ohio State University commencements derive from practices originating in the Middle Ages. When European universities were taking form in the 12th and 13th centuries, the scholars were usually clerics, and consequently they adopted costumes similar to those of their monastic orders. Cold halls and drafty buildings called for caps and floor-length capes with attached hoods, and the sobering influence of the church probably influenced the staid character of the caps and gowns.

As the control of the universities gradually passed from the church, some

aspects of the costumes took on brighter hues. Old prints and engravings, however, reveal a strong similarity between the regalia worn in early universities and that of the present day.

In light of our nation's English heritage, academic costume has been in use in the United States since colonial times. To establish a standard of uniformity in regard to the practice, an intercollegiate commission was formed to prepare a code for caps, gowns, and hoods that has since been adopted by all academic institutions.

Originally round, the shape of the cap is now the familiar mortarboard

square—a shape which, according to ballad folklore, resembles a scholar's book. Legend also has it that the privilege of wearing a cap was the initial right of a freed Roman slave; the academic cap, therefore, has become a sign of the freedom of scholarship. The flowing gown has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it covers any dress that might indicate rank or social status. The hood, reserved at The Ohio State University for those receiving doctoral degrees, not only indicates the type of degree, but also is lined with the official colors of the university.

The Gown

Bachelor: Black, full cut with long pointed sleeves.

Master: Black, long or short sleeves with arc-shaped panel extended for each sleeve.

Doctor: Black with velvet panels on front of gown and three velvet bars on each sleeve. Color of the velvet may be black or distinctive of the field of study.

Honors Emblem

The Ohio State University honors emblem is a scarlet and gray tasseled braid worn over the gown. Students eligible for this curricular honor are those graduating *summa cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, *cum laude*, with distinction, with honors in business, with honors in the liberal arts, and with honors in pharmacy.

The Hood

Bachelor: Three feet long with a two-inch-wide velvet edging.*

Master: Three and one-half feet long with a three-inch-wide velvet edging.*

Doctor: Four feet in length with a five-inch-wide velvet edging and panel at the sides.

The lining of all hoods, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree. The color of the velvet indicates the field of study:




Candidates for degrees at The Ohio State University wear the black mortarboard with a tassel whose color is distinctive of the degree being received. The tassel colors are as follows:


